Congregation Kol Chaverim opened its doors, Saturday morning, August 7, 2015, for the first Shabbat service at Liberty Tax Office in Pembroke Pines. The following Friday, August 13, 2015, we had our first Musical Kabbalat Shabbat. In July, 2015, Rabbi Marcelo Bader, guest speaker, presented an Adult Education Program, to an audience with over 35 people in attendance that evening. We continued with weekly Saturday morning services and once a month Friday Kabbalat Shabbat services in a storefront; up until the High Holidays 5776, at Cooper City Church of G-d, 9191 Stirling Rd., Cooper City, FL., offering a community wide, open to anyone needing a place to pray for the holidays for a minimum suggested donation. Immediately following High Holidays, we leased space at the Church, to hold weekly Shabbat Services, which has been serving as our temporary home up until the present time. Purim was held at the home of Marc Kaprow where the Megillah was read with singing and celebration. In April, second night of Pesach, we conducted a Community Seder for 23 people, using a Haggadah written by Rabbi Emeritus, Avraham Kapnek, given to the participants to take home.

The merger of a former synagogue established in the community for over 40 years, led the vision and direction to enable us to maintain a spiritual home, with a presence in the Davie/Cooper City/Pembroke Pines area. We heard "all your voices" through your support we wish to honor this commitment. We have grown to approximately over 100 membership units in one year. We continue to lease space in the Church for weekly Shabbat services, and, once a month Kabbalat Musical Shabbat, under the direction of Rabbi Emeritus, Avraham Kapnek and Cantor, Eric Lindenbaum; your commitment will also provide dynamic programming and the opportunity to invite Rabbinical students from the Seminary. Many of you expressed the desire and concern to have our own identity and space, our "fair share dues structure," is one of the most fundamental objectives of Kol Chaverim; in order to continue to provide membership dues at a low cost, the generosity of your pledge and support will ensure that "together our dream will become a reality!"
