

The Ohio State University Integrative Medicine Fellowship is a one-year program designed to train physicians in evidence-based therapies and associated philosophies collectively known as Integrative Medicine. Our program combines education, clinical mentorship, and hands-on training & practice with faculty who use evidence-based Integrative Medicine in our clinic and at our world-renowned academic medical center. The goal of the program is to provide physicians with a wide range of knowledge and skills needed to be successful practitioners in the field of Integrative Medicine as well as future leaders in health care organizations, academic medical centers, government and industry.

OSU Integrative Medicine will facilitate this training process through the guidance of the American Board of Integrative Medicine (ABoIM) and with specific training goals, learning objectives & activities facilitated by our expert faculty across a one-year calendar. This fellowship has been approved by the OSU Wexner Medical Center and College of Medicine (COM) Graduate Medical Education Office (GME).
