*Global Advances* is a peer-reviewed, open-access journal, created to provide global communications services for the rapidly developing worldwide movement in health and medicine that integrates knowledge of therapeutic approaches and lifestyle practices to promote health and healing. Our objective is to improve patient outcomes by fostering deeper dialogue among healthcare professionals from various disciplines, as well as across diverse practice patterns, cultures, and industry fields.

Our vision for *Global Advances* involves a broad and inclusive perspective on integrative medicine and health. We envision articles from clinical settings, community settings (e.g., community-based participatory research), basic scientists, and public health settings.
