

Academic Integrity Statement

The IMM Graduate School uses assessments to allow students the opportunity to provide evidence to show that they have mastered the content. The evidence provided must be relevant to the topic, demonstrate the student's current competency, and satisfy the examiner of the competency of the student against all criteria. To achieve this, evidence submitted for assessment must be authentic - all information presented must be current and entirely the work of the student and not from another source.

Students who register to study at the IMM Graduate School automatically agree to the following Academic Integrity Statement:

Declaration by the student:

1. I will not receive nor will I elicit any assistance from/to another student in the process of completion of any assessment.
