Overview of the Programme

The Postgraduate Diploma in Supply Chain Management is an IMM Graduate School qualification registered at NQF Level 8 (SAQA ID 125997) and quality assured by the Council on Higher Education (CHE) South Africa.

This qualification is designed for professionals who already have a strong business foundation and wish to change career paths, enhance their qualifications, move into management, or specialise in supply chain management. The programme develops advanced supply chain knowledge, strategic thinking, and practical problem-solving skills that can be applied across a wide range of industries.

Students explore contemporary supply chain management models, procurement and strategic sourcing, international trade and logistics, risk management in supply chains, and supply chain technologies, while learning to analyse complex business challenges using real-world case studies.



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1 Career and Further Study Progression

Graduates who achieve a final average of 60% or higher, subject to the IMM Graduate School's admission requirements, may qualify for admission to the Master's Research and Proposal Writing (MRPW) module.

This qualification provides a pathway towards master's level study and supports progression into senior supply chain leadership roles.

2 Programme Structure

The Postgraduate Diploma in Supply Chain Management consists of six compulsory modules. Assessment combines coursework, practical application, and continuous assessment throughout the programme.

Assessments include:

- Module assignments.
- Open-book examinations in selected modules.
- Completion of an Applied Supply Chain Project, including practical online supply chain simulations, group assignments, presentations, and a final assessment.

- Recommend and justify the use of cutting-edge technologies and analytical tools within the supply chain to optimise processes and enhance decision-making capabilities.
