Directions For Use

Read the entire label before using this product.

For all surfaces, test on a small area before use. TO CLEAN TOILETS AND URINALS: Remove water from bowl by forcing it over the trap with a swab mop. Saturate swab with cleaner and wet all surfaces thoroughly. It is most important to swab under rim of bowl or urinal to clean water outlets. Allow this cleaner to remain for at least 10 minutes until all rust, scale and stains are loosened. Rinse by flushing.

Safety

DANGER: CORROSIVE. Causes irreversible eye damage or skin burns. May be fatal if swallowed. Harmful if adsorbed through skin or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wear goggles or face shield. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. **FIRST AID:** IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless instructed to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. IF ON SKIN OR ON CLOTHING: Immediately take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 - 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container (bottle, can, bucket). Wrap (container) and put in trash. SEE MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET.
