General Use Directions

Initial Applications

- 1. Read all of the precautionary information prior to use.
- 2. Strip all old finish from the floor using a 3M™ stripping pad and appropriate 3M™ stripper.
- 3. Rinse the floor.
- Allow the floor to dry thoroughly. Dust the floor with a 3M[™] Doodleduster or 3M[™] Easy Trap[™] Cloth.

NOTE: The minimum application temperature for 3M[™] Cornerstone[™] Sealer/Finish is 50°F (10°C).

 Apply three to four coats of 3M[™] Cornerstone[™] Sealer/Finish, allowing each coat to dry completely before applying the next coat (a minimum of 30 minutes).

(i) IMPORTANT NOTE

Do NOT pour unused product back into the original container.

NOTE: Coverage on very porous substrates (i.e. concrete, terrazzo) is 600-1,200 sq. ft/gal (14.7-29.5 sq m/l). On less porous substrates (i.e. composition vinyl tile) coverage is

Cleaning

- Dust mop the floor with a 3M[™] Doodleduster or 3M[™] Easy Trap[™] Cloth.
- Damp mop or auto scrub the floor as necessary using 3M[™] Neutral Cleaner and a 3M[™] Red Buffer Pad 5100 on an auto scrubber.

Repair

- Clean the floor with an appropriate cleaner and pad to remove any marks or debris.
- 2. Burnish the floor with an appropriate 3M burnishing pad.
