Stevan's mission now is to educate teens about the warning signs of deadly alcohol poisoning, the dangers of binge drinking, Indiana's Lifeline Law, and to basically Make Good Decisions. At the conclusion of his presentation he asks audience members to take the Make Good Decisions 3-Part Pledge:

1. I will do my best to Make Good Decisions
2. If a friend needs help, I will Make The Call
3. If I need help, I give you permission to Make The Call

He doesn't want other families and friends to unnecessarily and tragically lose another life.
