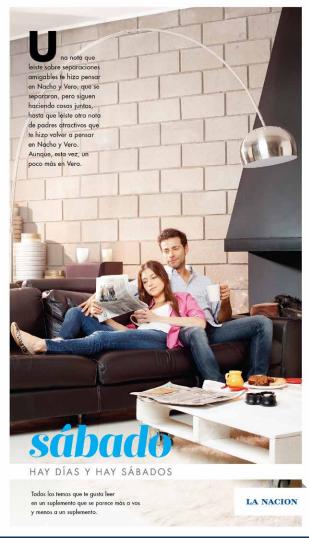

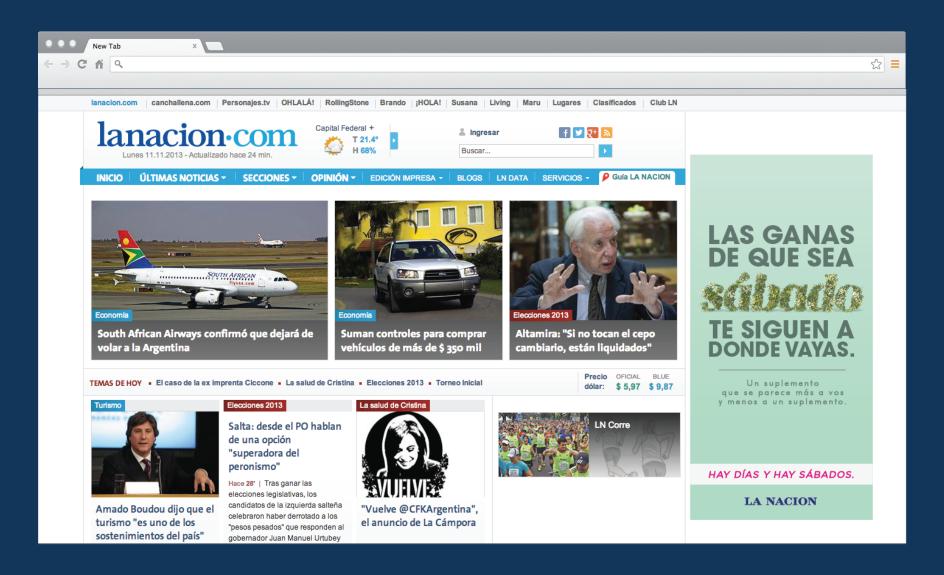


Expandable banner showing 3 "Sabado" articles that were updated constantly
