ADULT DEVELOPMENT

Beyond Bars

Biblical foundations, instruction, and case studies for those considering a ministry to inmates, ex-offenders and their families.

CareerLink

Uses assessment, stabilization and spiritual resources that address practical, social, and emotional roadblocks to meaningful employment. It encourages development of a life plan and career path as opposed to a “just get a job” mentality.

COMPASSION IN ACTION

Boxes of Love®

Provides a Thanksgiving meal to a family who many not otherwise have one. Each box includes food to feed a family of six, plus relevant scriptural material.

Holiday Care Boxes

Similar to the Boxes of Love, includes a holiday meal for six and is distributed in December (Christmas Time).

Easter Bags

Plain paper bags filled with some of the things inner-city children treasure: candy, fruit, crayons, a toy ... a full-color children's activity book about Jesus, for children with little church background.

Heart & Sole™

Providing shoes and God's love to inner-city children in need.

Homeless Care Kits

Each Kit includes a blanket, warm gloves, a scarf, socks, toothbrush, soap, and spiritual materials.

PowerPacks™

Backpacks with school supplies and age appropriate spiritual materials.
