

Viva Aerobus provides information concerning flight 9138 from Veracruz-Cancun

Mexico City, June 11th, 2018.- Viva Aerobus provides the following information regarding flight 9138 from Veracruz - Cancun:

- Around 2200 hours, on June 11th, 2018, one of our aircraft covering the distance Veracruz - Cancun, flight 9138, registered abnormal engine parameters for one engine due to a bird ingestion.
- As a precautionary measure, the aircraft returned to Veracruz International Airport (MMVR) to be overhauled by our maintenance team and the Mexican aviation authority.
- The aircraft landed safely without further incidents being reported and all passengers and crew members safe and sound. Viva Aerobus will provide food, flight changes, lodging or reimbursements for all passengers, according to the Mexican Civil Aviation Law.
- For Viva Aerobus, the safety in its operations and its passengers is the top priority.
