ANNOUNCEMENT: The Isle of Wight motor Cycle Club will organise an open event held under the National Sporting Code and the Trials Standing Regulations of the ACU, and any Final Instructions that may be issued. A trial for Classic Twin shock, Pre 65 and mono-shock machines of any manufacture with an option to ride a course with some road work. Marking will be in accordance with TSR 22 A, STOP PERMITTED.

ELIGIBILITY: Riders must hold a current ACU Trials affiliation card or SACU licence. All riders opting for Course A must have machines that comply with Road Traffic Acts and ACU requirements, it is the <u>sole</u> responsibility of the rider to ensure that <u>all</u> legal requirements are met. All machines are to be fitted with Trials tyres – No other tyre type will be permitted.

COURSE: There will be two courses:

Course A - will comprise leaving the opening group, by road, for <u>one</u> lap of twelve sections at the away group, followed by <u>two</u> laps of twelve sections back at the opening group, involving no more than 14 miles of road work each day.

Course B - will comprise of <u>three</u> laps of twelve sections, all on private land, at the opening group with no road work.

Riders may enter either course. Each section will have an Expert, Hard/Inter, Easy/Novice and Beginner route. All sections will be straight forward with natural hills, tree roots and climbs.

START: The start for Saturday will be Knighton Sandpit (postcode PO36 0NT) at 11.00 hrs and the start for Sunday will be Bembridge Down (postcode PO36 8QT) at 10.00 hrs.

CLASSES:

Course A (Roadwork) Twin Shock Hard: Class 1 Twin Shock Easy: Class 2

Pre 65 Hard: Class 3 Pre 65 Easy: Class 4

Open Hard/Inter: Class 5 Open Easy/Novice Class 6

Course B (All off road) Twin shock Hard: Class 7 Twin Shock Easy: Class 8

Expert: Class 9 Youth Expert: Class 10

Open Hard/Inter: Class 11 Open Easy/Novice: Class 12

Youth Hard/Inter: Class 13 Youth Easy/Novice: Class 14

Adult Beginner: Class 15 Youth Beginner: Class 16

Machines of any type/manufacture can be used in Classes 5,6 and Classes 9 to 16.

ROUTES: Expert: to ride Blue/Red with White deviations.

Hard and Inters: to ride Blue/Red, no deviations.

Easy and **Novice:** to ride Yellow only, no deviations.

Beginners: to ride Pink only, no deviations.
