ANNOUNCEMENT: The Isle of Wight motor Cycle Club will organise an open event held under the National Sporting Code and the Trials Standing Regulations of the ACU, and any Final Instructions that may be issued. A trial for Classic Twin-Shock, Pre 65 and Mono-Shock Trials machines of any manufacture, with an option to ride a course with some road work. Marking will be in accordance with TSR 22 A, STOP PERMITTED.

ELIGIBILITY: Riders must hold a current ACU Trials affiliation card or SACU licence. All riders opting for Course A must have machines that comply with The Road Traffic Act and ACU requirements, it is the **sole responsibility** of the rider to ensure that **all legal requirements** are met. All machines are to be fitted with trials tyres – No other tyre type will be permitted.

COURSE: There will be two courses:

Course A - will comprise leaving the opening group, by road, for twelve sections at the away group, followed by twelve sections back at the opening group, involving no more than 14 miles of road work each day. A maximum of three laps, at each venue, will be negotiated over the weekend.

Course B - will comprise of **three** laps of twelve sections, all on private land, at the opening group with no road work. Both days will be treated as separate qualifying rounds for the Southern Centre ACU, Solo Star Championship – open to all Southern Centre registered riders (please see appendix).

Riders may enter either course. Each section will have an Expert, Intermediate/Hard, Novice/Easy and a Beginner route. All sections will be straight forward with natural hills, tree roots and climbs.

START: The start for Saturday will be Knighton Sandpit (postcode PO36 0NT) at 11:00 hrs, signing on from 9am. The start for Sunday will be Bembridge Down (postcode PO36 8QT) at 10:00 hrs.

Beginners: to ride Pink only, no deviations.

ENTRIES: Entries are Strictly **limited** to **150** and will open on Monday 5th November 2018 and close on Friday 19th April 2019. **No late entries will be accepted.** (**Entry Conditions apply to all Adult IOWMCC Members, please see appendix**). Rider numbers will be balloted in classes and posted on the Club website by 22nd April. A list of entries will be posted on the website as they are received (confirmation of entry). Entries should be posted to the Secretary of the Meeting together with an e-mail address **or** SAE (for postal results) together with the correct entry fee.

FEES: Adults: **£30** Youths: **£20** Cheques & postal orders should be made out to IOWMCC Ltd.

RESULTS: Will appear on the club website (**within two days after the trial**). Results will also be available by e-mail or posted via Royal Mail, if preferred (please enclose a SAE for postal results).

FREE SOCIAL EVENING: We are holding a free social evening on the Saturday from 7.30pm at Smallbrook Stadium (home of the Islands Speedway team) Ashey Road, Ryde PO33 4BH. There will be a free buffet and disco - you will however need to pay for your drinks at the bar!

Appendix

IOWMCC Members (only) Entry Conditions

All Isle of Wight MCC (Adult) Members are required to name a helper, who will be available for one of the two trial days. This measure is being introduced to ensure we have enough people to staff the trial properly across the weekend, particularly to guarantee we have enough Observers.

Please make sure you clearly write the name and contact phone No of your named helper and which day they are available - on the back of your entry form. If there is no name you will be subject to the following!

For Club Members that are unable to provide a helper, they will be entered into a draw. 12 names will be pulled out for Saturday and another 12 for Sunday – if we are short of observers then these riders will be expected to forfeit their ride for that day.

For example, if we are 3 observers short on Saturday then the first 3 riders from the Saturday draw will be given a section to observe.

Members will only be entered into one draw (Saturday or Sunday).

The draw will take place, asap, after the entry has closed and riders drawn will be notified on or before Monday 22nd April.

A 50% refund of the entry fee will be made to any rider that is required to forfeit under this scheme.

IOWMCC Youth riders and Course Setters are not subject to this condition.

Southern Centre ACU Solo Star Championship Classifications:

All Centre Championship classes are restricted to the B Course only (all off road) as follows:

Expert:	(class 10)	Red & Blue with White deviations.
Clubman (Inter):	(class 11)	Red & Blue only.
Novice:	(class 12)	Yellow only.
Pre 65 (C):	(class 9)	Yellow only.
Twin Shock (C):	(class 8)	Yellow only.
Adult Beginner (D):	(class 16)	Pink only.
Youth A (Yth Exp):	(class 13)	Red & Blue with White deviations.
Youth B (Yth Inter):	(class 14)	Red & Blue only.
Youth C (Yth Nov):	(class 15)	Yellow only.
Youth D (Yth Beg):	(class 17)	Pink only.
