ANNOUNCEMENT: The Isle of Wight Motor Cycle Club will organise a **CLOSED to CLUB** event held under the National Sporting Code and the Trials Standing Regulations of the ACU, and any Final Instructions that may be issued. A trial for Mono-Shock, Classic Twin-Shock and Pre 65 trials machines.

ELIGIBILITY: Riders must be a member of The Isle of Wight Motorcycle Club. Members must also hold a current ACU Trials Registration. **No one day ACU licenses/Registrations are available.**
All machines are to be fitted with trials tyres only – No other tyre type will be permitted.

SPECTATORS: **NO Spectators are permitted**, until further notice.

ENTRIES: You must not enter this event if you have any symptoms related to the Covid-19 virus – including (but not limited to) a fever, a new persistent cough or a change in or loss of taste or smell. If you develop symptoms after entering – please notify The Secretary of the Meeting by email, text message or by phone, asap – **You should not** under any circumstances attend the trial.

By entering this event you will be accepting and agreeing to be bound by the conditions/precautions contained in these Supplementary Regulations.

Entries will be limited to 40 riders and will open 8am, Monday 10th May 2021 and close 6pm, Saturday 15th May 2021. **No late entries can be accepted.** Entry window will close sooner if the limit is reached before this date. Entries can only be made via the ACU online entry system (members portal). **It will not be possible to accept entries on the day.** Pre-entry only. **DO NOT** arrive at the venue unless you have received confirmation of entry by email – as you will be asked to leave.

FEES: Adults: **£15** Youths: **£5**

COURSE: Will comprise of four laps of eight sections, all on private land, that must be ridden in numerical order. There will be a strict 4 hour time limit. Sections will close at 4:00pm. All vehicles must be off site by 4:45pm.

Each section will have an Expert (A), Intermediate (B), Novice (C) and an Easy route (D). All sections will be straight forward with natural hills, tree roots and climbs. **All riders should only attempt routes that are well within their own capabilities.**

START: The trial will be held at Newbarn Farm, Calbourne, PO30 4JA. Start time: 12:00 pm. **Please do not arrive before 11:15am.**

RESULTS: Results will be available from the Club website, within four days of the trial, following a period of section score card quarantine.

ROUTES:

Expert	(A):	to follow Blue/Red with Green deviations.
Intermediate/Over 50/Yth Expert	(B):	to follow Blue/Red only, no deviations.
Clubman/Yth Inter:	(B&C):	to follow 50/50 mix, Blue/Red only – Yellow only, no deviations.
Novice/T-shock/Yth Novice	(C):	to follow Yellow only, no deviations.
Clubman C	(C&D):	to follow 50/50 mix Yellow only – White only, no deviations.
Adult Easy/Yth Easy	(D):	to follow White only, no deviations.
Sportsman	(A,B,C,D):	free to switch between routes, section by section.

COVID-19 restrictions/precautions:

Riders / Officials (from a maximum) of 2 separate households are permitted to attend in a single vehicle.

No Spectators are permitted.

Observers are to provide their own pen.

All competitors are required to supply their own pen (for section score recording - on sections with no observer).

Youth competitors must be accompanied by at least one parent or guardian.

On arrival, you will be checked in & directed to park your vehicle. When parking, a 2 metre space must be left between all other vehicles. There is no requirement for riders to sign on & there will be no other type of Administration tasks undertaken on site.

Strict Social Distancing (2 metres, minimum) to be maintained throughout the entire time on site, both on and off the bike, including the loading/unloading of machines.

Riders must form into groups of up to 6 maximum. If one of the group needs to return to the parking area, for any reason – the whole group must also return. This also applies when travelling back to the sections from the parking area. No rider should be moving around the venue alone – except to get help following an accident or other medical emergency.

Rider groups should nominate **one** rider, to record the scores of every rider in that group (for sections without a dedicated Observer).

A maximum of 3 riders, at any one time, are permitted to walk the section before attempting it, whilst always maintaining the Social Distancing rule.

Whilst queuing to enter the section - riders are to remain seated on the bike, 2 metres apart, ideally in a single line. Only one rider is permitted to attempt the section at a time. Rider groups should wait until all riders in their group have finished the section before moving (as a group) onto the next section.

PPE: 70% alcohol hand sanitiser gel will be available for all officials and riders across the venue. Face masks & gloves will also be available - for officials only.

Riders should bring their own face covering/mask if preferred. All riders are to wear riding gloves.

Any Final Instructions will either be sent by email the evening before the trial or posted on the notice board in the parking area.
