ANNOUNCEMENT: The Isle of Wight Motorcycle Club will organise an open event held under the National Sporting Code and the Trials Standing Regulations of the ACU, and any Final Instructions that may be issued.

A trial for Mono-Shock, Classic Twin-Shock and Pre 67 trials machines. Marking will be in accordance with TSR 22 A, STOPS PERMITTED.

ELIGIBILITY: Riders must hold a current ACU Trials Registration or SACU Licence.

<u>COURSE</u>: Will comprise three laps of twelve sections, all on private land. Each day will be treated as separate qualifying rounds for the Southern Centre ACU, Solo Star Championship – open to all Southern Centre riders. (please see appendix for championship classifications).

Each section will have 4 routes: A, B, C & D. All sections will be straightforward with natural hills, tree roots and climbs.

START: The start for Saturday will be **Bembridge Down at 10:00 am**, signing on from 9am. Postcode: **PO36 8QT**, What 3 Words: **Lighters. Jukebox. Decreased**.

The start for Sunday will be **Knighton Sandpit at 09:30 am**. Postcode **PO36 0NT**. What 3 Words: **Explained. Completed. Singles**.

Riders will be started in classes. Full starting details will be published in the Final Instructions. The sections will close after 6 hrs & 30 mins, each day.

ENTRIES: Entries are strictly limited to 150. No late entries will be accepted.

A list of confirmed entries will be posted on the club website (Forms section) as they are received.

Enter online only, using the ACU's Sport 80 system (from Monday 23rd June 2025). Entries will close on Sunday 1st September or sooner if the limit is reached before this date. No late entries can be accepted.

(Entry Conditions apply to all Adult IOWMCC Members - please see appendix).

Rider numbers will be balloted in classes and posted on the Club website by Friday 12th September.

ENTRY FEE: Adult: £50 Youth: £25

RESULTS: Will be published on the club website (within three days of the trial).

Appendix

IOWMCC Members (only) Entry Conditions

All Isle of Wight MCC (Adult) riders will be required to nominate a helper, who must be available for one of the two trial days. This measure has been introduced to ensure we have enough people to staff the trial properly, across the weekend, particularly to guarantee we have enough observers.

IOWMCC riders need to provide the details of their nominated helper as part of the online entry process or by informing the Secretary of the Meeting separately. If there is no nomination - IOWMCC riders will be subject to the following:

IOWMCC riders who are unable to provide a helper will be entered into one of two draws. One draw for Saturday and another for Sunday – if we are short of observers then these riders will be expected to forfeit their ride for that day. Members will only be entered into one draw (Saturday or Sunday).

For example, if we are 3 observers short on Saturday then the first 3 names from the Saturday draw will be given a section to observe.

The draw will take place asap after the entry has closed and riders drawn will be notified on or before Monday 8th September.

A 50% refund of the entry fee will be made to any rider that is required to forfeit under this scheme.

IOWMCC Youth riders and Course Setters are <u>not subject</u> to this condition.
