ANNOUNCEMENT: The Isle of Wight Motorcycle Club will organise a 'Closed to Club' event held under the National Sporting Code and the Trials Standing Regulations of the ACU, and any Final Instructions that may be issued. A trial for Mono-Shock, Classic Twin-Shock and Pre 65 trials machines.

ELIGIBILITY: Riders must hold a current IOWMCC membership and a valid ACU Trials Registration. All machines are to be fitted with trials tyres – No other tyre type will be permitted.

SPECTATORS: Spectators are permitted. Spectators should not enter the sections & must follow any instructions given by Trial Officials and Observers.

ENTRIES:

By entering this event you will be accepting and agreeing to be bound by the conditions/precautions contained in these Supplementary Regulations.

Entries will be limited to 50 riders and will open 8am, Monday 23rd February 2026 and will close on Saturday 28th February 2026 at 6pm. **No late entries can be accepted.** Entry window will close sooner if the limit is reached before this date. Entries can only be made via the ACU, Sport 80, online platform. **It will not be possible to accept entries on the day.** Pre-entry only. **DO NOT arrive at the venue unless you have received confirmation of entry by email.**

FEES: Adult: **£15** Youth: **£8**

CLUB RIDER No BIBS: Club rider number bibs must be worn. **Failure to do so may result in a 20-point penalty being added to the offending rider's total.**

COURSE: Will comprise of four laps of eight sections - or five laps of six sections, all on private land, that must be ridden in numerical order. There will be a strict 3 hours and 30 minutes time limit. Sections will close at 2:00pm. All vehicles must be off site by 3:00pm.

Each section will have an Expert (A), Intermediate (B), Novice (C) and an Easy route (D). All sections will be straight forward with natural hills, tree roots and climbs. **All riders should only attempt routes that are well within their own capabilities.**

START: The trial will be held at **Newbarn Farm, Calbourne. PO30 4JA.**

What 3 Words location: **Reapply. Underline. Foiled.** Start time: 10:30am. **Please do not arrive before 09:30am. The starting of machines before 10:15 is strictly prohibited.**

RESULTS: Results will be available from the Club website, within four days of the trial.

Adult Easy/Youth Easy	(D):	To follow Yellow only.
Sportsman	(A,B,C,D):	Free to switch between routes, section by section.
