

## Module 1 Lesson 2 - Hardware Definition - Action Steps

Here, you are creating your own forms, and checklist to help you list a series of components needed for your IP Office Deployment.

**Action One** - Create a form that describes the different IP500V2 Hardware components, allowing your customer to choose from a list of devices to suit their needs. Some of these devices or components can be=

- IP Office Daughter Cards (Combo, Digital 8, ISDN Daughter Cards, VCM, etc.)
- IP Addresses - Have your customer give you a local network IP Address
- Power Failure Jacks (These are use to allow the user to call the local authorities in case the IP Office loses power)
- Types of expansion Modules

**Action Two** - For those deploying Server Edition, or a conventional IP500V2 with Adjuncts, be sure to include some of these components in your installation checklist=

- Platform to be deployed (IP500V2 /SE / Server Types)
- Messaging Options (VMPRO / Embedded voicemail)
- Locations (Here you want to let your customer list the remote locations to be attached to the core site)
- Deployment types (This should be done in the pre-sales stage, but it is important to note it here)
- Type of adjuncts
- Phone types
