“Ming and Qing Studies” are a bridge between ancient and contemporary China. Such studies have been developed in Italy in the last decades. On the occasion of the recent publication of two books on this topic (“Ming Qing Studies” 2013 and “L'impero del Mandato Celeste. La Cina nei secoli XIV-XIX”), the Confucius Institute at Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore has invited scholars from a number of universities and academic institutions to give their contribution to this two-day workshop.

International publications which add to the literature on the subject are the annual “Ming Qing yanjiu” (1992 to 2007) and “Ming Qing Studies” (2010 to date). A new series dedicated to this period is entitled “Emotions and States of Mind in East Asia” and published by Brill Publications.
