## **i-Team Cyclist's Club** General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) Statement

Last Updated 17/05/2018

The **General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)** is a legal framework that sets guidelines for the collection and processing of personal information of individuals within the European Union (EU).

To function as a club in the manner that we do, we need our members to give their consent to store some personal information about them, therefore in line with [British Cycling](#) Guidelines we need to advise you of the following:

As a member of the i-Team Cyclists' Club, you must agree that we may store and hold some personal data about you, such as your full name, date of birth, address, photograph, next of kin etc,

Some of your information such as your photo, home town, date of birth may be shared on the club website. In addition, some limited information, such as you name and photographs of you may be shared on social media pages or in emails sent by the club. This data will be shared for the purposes of building team spirit and for promoting the club to potential members in the wider cycling community.

Limited further information about you may be included; for example, whether you have participated in a male junior race or a senior women's race. This information, including any photographs that you have shared publicly on your personal social media that relates to cycling or i-Team.cc may be shared publicly on i-Team.cc social media (including [Portsmouth School of Cycle Racing](#).)

When you become a member of or renew your membership with the i-Team Cyclists' Club, you will be registered for an online account with British Cycling. We will provide British Cycling with your personal data which they will use to enable access to an online portal for you (called My Dashboard) on the British Cycling website. British Cycling will use your personal data in accordance with its Privacy Notice which can be accessed [HERE](#).

British Cycling will then contact you to invite you to sign into and update your dashboard (which, amongst other things, allows you to set and amend your privacy settings). The British Cycling online Club Management tool allows the export of club member data in full or in the form of a queried report. From time to time we may export or copy some or all of the information held about you (for example, downloading next of kin information to give to a coach or volunteer managing a club activity), N.B. we do not have access to financial details such as credit card numbers.

Any data exported in this way be stored securely at all times and will not be used for any purpose that is not directly linked to club administration.
