

## Find the Domain of Composite Functions

Given two functions,  $f(x)$  and  $g(x)$ , the composite function, written  $f \circ g$ , is defined as

$$(f \circ g)(x) = f(g(x))$$

The domain of  $f \circ g$  is the set of all numbers  $x$  in the domain of function  $g$  such that  $g(x)$  is in the domain of function  $f$ .

$$f(x) = \frac{4}{x-4} \quad g(x) = 2x + 2$$

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
