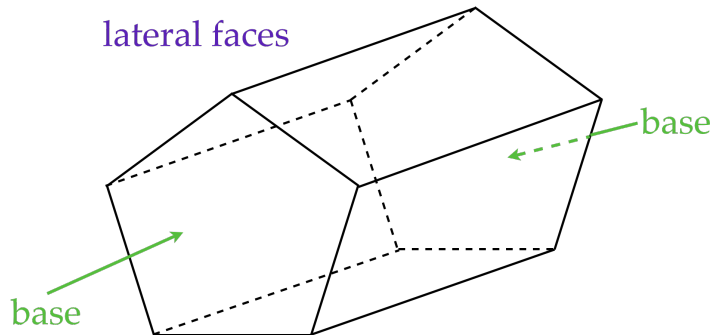


Prism

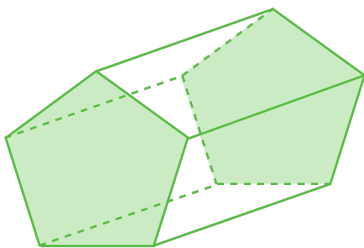
a **solid** with exactly two congruent faces, called **bases**.

Prism

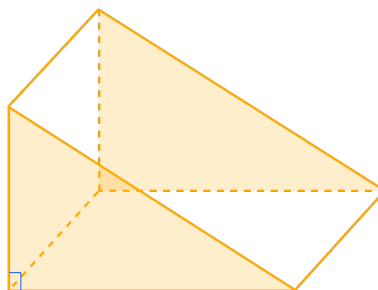
a **prism** is named by the shape of its **bases**.

Hexagonal Prism



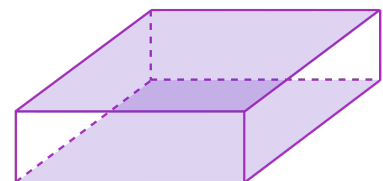
Hexagon

Rectangular Prism



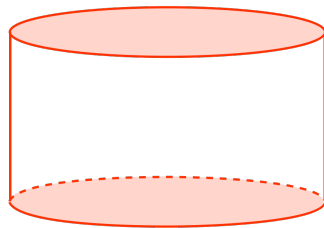

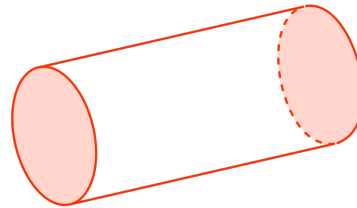
Circular Prism

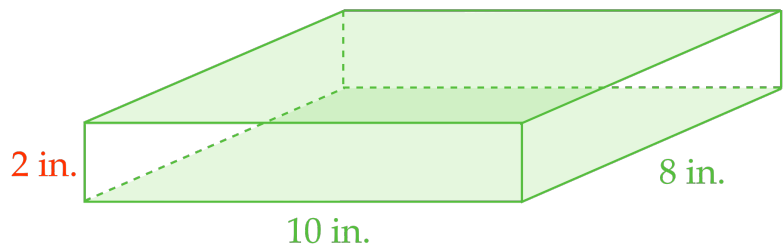
Prism
