Cut your Medicare prescription drug costs with Extra Help

Great news: Thanks to the new prescription drug law, the Inflation Reduction Act, in 2024 people with Medicare may qualify for even more savings through the Extra Help program to pay for their prescription costs. Those who qualify will not be subject to the coverage gap or a late enrollment penalty. Many people are eligible for these savings and don't even know it.

In 2024, everyone who qualifies for Extra Help will pay:

- \$0 for your Medicare drug plan premium.
- \$0 for your plan deductible.
- A reduced amount for both generic and brand-name drugs.
