

**Thinking of putting in a Residential Swimming Pool? Before you do make sure you have the following:**

- ☐ Farmington Valley Health Department Approval
- ☐ Zoning Approval
- ☐ Permit Applications
  - Zoning Permit
  - Pool Permit – Aboveground, Inground or Onground
  - Electrical Permit – for associated Pool Equipment
  - Plumbing Permit – if applicable
  - Pool Barrier Permit

***Note: It is the Homeowners responsibility to ensure ALL necessary pool permits have been applied for and approved by the Building Official. Often times the Pool Company installing the Pool will NOT obtain the Barrier and/or Electrical Permits for the job.***

- ☐ Detailed Site Plan (cannot be hand drawn)
  - Must include Setback dimensions from Home, Property Lines & Other Buildings
  - Must include any presence of Wetlands on site
- ☐ Certified Engineered Plans for the Specific Pool being Installed at the Permit address location
- ☐ Structural Details
- ☐ Plumbing/ Pump Equipment Locations
- ☐ Setback & Fence/ Barrier requirements must be met
