We have two Resource Center in Plainfield and Brownsburg that serve as hubs for those struggling. We also have an overnight shelter, Almost Home, on the north side of Plainfield. Through a network of community support, we provide emergency and permanent housing, homelessness prevention and stability services, such as a child care, transportation, jobs and most of all lots of love. In 2021, we ended homelessness for 105 families and prevented it for 585 families!
