

The Family Promise organization ("Family Promise") proposes to acquire the Hope Presbyterian Church ("HPC Property") located at 1313 Section Street in Plainfield, Indiana. During the August 23, 2022 public comment meeting hosted by Family Promise concerning this acquisition, several issues related to Family Promise's proposed security and maintenance procedures became obvious. Set forth below are several comments concerning such procedures:

(1) Does Family Promise have any written security and maintenance procedures for the parking lot and grassy areas of the premises of the HPC Property? If Family Promise does have such procedures, will Family Promise agree to make those procedures available for review by the Plainfield community? If Family Promise does not agree to make those procedures available for such review, explain in detail why it will not make those procedures available for such review.

(2) Does Family Promise have any written business plan for financing the security and maintenance of the parking lot and grassy areas of the premises of the HPC Property? If Family Promise does have such a business plan, will Family Promise agree to make such business plan available for review by the Plainfield community? If Family Promise will not agree to make the business plan available for such review, explain in detail why Family Promise will not make such business plan available for such review.

(3) Does Family Promise have any written projection of the 10 year revenues and costs estimates for the security and maintenance of the parking lot and grassy areas of the premises of the HPC Property? If Family Promise has such a projection (or for any period of fewer than or more than 10 years), will Family Promise agree to make such projection available for review by the Plainfield community? If Family Promise will not agree to make such projection available for such review, explain in detail why Family Promise will not agree to make such projection available for such review.

(4) Does Family Promise propose to erect any additional fencing around all, or any part, of the premises of the HPC Property? If Family Promise proposes to erect any such additional fencing, describe in detail such additional fencing. If Family Promise does not propose to erect any such additional fencing, explain in detail why Family Promise does not propose to erect any such additional fencing.

(5) Does Family Promise propose to erect any additional fencing between the premises of the HPC Property and the residential real estate which physically abuts the premises of the HPC Property on the East side of the HPC Property? If Family Promise does not propose to erect any such additional fencing, explain in detail why Family Promise does not propose to erect such additional fencing. Will Family Promise agree to make available for review by the Plainfield community any such proposed additional fencing plans? If Family Promise will not agree to make any such proposed additional fencing plans available for Plainfield community review, explain in detail the answer why Family Promise will not agree to make any such proposed additional fencing available for review by the Plainfield community. (6) Does Family Promise have any written plans or procedures for how Family Promise proposes to provide security and maintenance of the parking lot and grassy areas of the HPC Property? If Family Promise has any such plans or procedures, will Family Promise agree to make such plans or procedures available for Plainfield community review? If Family Promise will not agree to make such plans or procedures available for Plainfield community review, explain in detail why Family Promise will not agree to make any such plans or procedures available for Plainfield community review.

(7) Explain in writing, and in detail, how Family Promise proposes to provide security of the parking lot and grassy areas of the HPC Property before, during and after, the hours of Family Promise's daily operation of the homeless facility that Family Promise proposes to operate at the HBC Property. Does Family Promise agree that it is important for the Plainfield community to know in advance of Family Promise's acquisition of the HPC Property how specifically Family Promise proposes to provide security of the parking lot and grassy areas of the HPC Property? If Family Promise does not agree that it is important for the Plainfield community to know in advance of Family Promise's acquisition of the HPC Property how Family Promise proposes to provide security of the parking lot and grassy areas of the HPC Property, explain in detail why Family Promise does not do agree.

(8) Explain in writing, and in detail, how Family Promise proposes to secure the parking lot and grassy areas of the HPC Property (both before and after the designated and approved operational hours of the facility that Family Promise proposes to operate at the HPC Property) so that there will be: (i) no ingress by unauthorized vehicles or persons to such parking lot or grassy areas outside of such operational hours; and (ii) no unauthorized vehicles or persons (or their associated property) remaining on such

parking lot or grassy areas outside of such operational hours. Does Family Promise agree that it is important for the Plainfield community to know how Family Promise proposes to provide such security before Family Promise acquires the HPC Property? If Family Promise does not so agree, explain in detail why Family Promise does not so agree.

(9) Explain in writing, and in detail, how Family Promise proposes to provide security (both before and after the designated and approved operational hours of the facility that Family Promise proposes to operate at the HPC Property) for the parking lot and grassy areas of the aHPC Property by removing any unauthorized vehicles or persons (and their associated property, trash or waste) from such parking lot or grassy areas remaining on such parking lot or grassy areas outside of such approved and designated hours. Does Family Promise propose to rely in any manner on Plainfield law enforcement, fire services, waste disposal or other emergency services personnel to assist in the removal of any such unauthorized vehicles or persons (or their associated property, trash or waste) from such parking lot or grassy areas? If Family Promise proposes to rely in any manner on Plainfield law enforcement, fire services, waste removal or other emergency services personnel in assisting in any such removal, explain in detail how they will assist. If Family Promise does not propose to so rely on Plainfield law enforcement, fire services, waste removal or other emergency services personnel, explain in writing, and in detail, how Family Promise proposes to remove any unauthorized vehicles or persons (and their associated property, trash or waste) from such parking lot or grassy areas. Does Family Promise agree that it is important that Family Promise remove any vehicles or persons (and their associated property, trash and waste) remaining on such parking lot or grassy areas outside of the approved and designated operational hours of the facility that Family Promise at the HPC Property? If Family Promise does not so agree, explain in writing, and in detail, why Family Promise does not so agree. Does Family Promise agree that it is important for the Plainfield community to know (in advance of the acquisition of the HPC Property) how Family Promise proposes to remove (from the parking lot or grassy areas of the HPC Property) any vehicles or persons (and their associated property, trash and waste) remaining on such parking lot or grassy areas outside of the approved and designated operational hours of the facility that Family Promise proposes to operate at the HPC Property? If Family Promise does not so agree, explain in writing, and in detail, your why Family Promise does so agree.
