

The Family Promise organization ("Family Promise") proposes to acquire the Hope Presbyterian Church ("HPC Property") located at 1313 Section Street in Plainfield, Indiana. During the August 23, 2022 public comment meeting hosted by Family Promise concerning this acquisition, several issues related to Family Promise's proposed security procedures became obvious. Set forth below are several comments related to such procedures:

(1) Does Family Promise have any written plans to install any security cameras or security lighting to help secure the parking lot and grassy areas of the HPC Property? Will Family Promise agree to provide for review by the Plainfield Community any such plans? If Family Promise will not agree to provide such plans for Plainfield community review, explain in detail why Family Promise will not agree to so provide such plans. Explain any proposals Family Promise may have for any additional security cameras or lighting which Family Promise proposes to help secure the parking lot and grassy areas of the HPC Property.

(3) In order to discourage or prohibit any person receiving services at the homeless facility on the HPC Property from residing, living or otherwise squatting in an unauthorized manner on any public or private property in the residential neighborhood in the immediate vicinity of the HPC Property, does Family Promise propose to permanently or indefinitely bar such person determined to be residing, living or otherwise squatting on any such property from receiving future services at the homeless facility on the HPC Property? Explain in writing, and in detail, any procedures or other measures which Family Promise proposes to implement so as to discourage or prohibit any person receiving services at the homeless facility on the HPC Property from residing, living or otherwise squatting in an unauthorized manner on any public or private property in the residential neighborhood in the immediate vicinity of the HPC Property.

(4) Does Family Promise agree that both the residential neighborhood in the immediate vicinity of the HPC Property, and the parking lot and grassy areas of the HPC Property, are each significantly different from the surroundings and premises of the Family Promise Resource Center on Vine Street ("Vine Street Center") in Plainfield, Indiana? If Family Promise does not so agree, explain in writing, and in detail, why Family Promise does not so agree.

(5) Will Family Promise agree to make available for review by the Plainfield community (or otherwise describe) any procedures or measures that Family Promise may have in effect which address the security and maintenance of the Vine Street Center? Will Family Promise agree to make available for review by the Plainfield community (or otherwise describe) any procedures or measures that Family Promise may have in effect to discourage or prohibit any person receiving services at the Vine Street Center from residing, living or otherwise squatting in an unauthorized manner on any public or private property in the vicinity of the Vine Street Center? If Family Promise will not agree to make available for review by the Plainfield community (or otherwise describe) any procedures or measures addressed by the two immediate questions in this Item (5), explain in writing, and in detail, why Family Promise will not so agree.
