Questions or Comments for the Town of Plainfield	<p>Will the data center corporation receive a tax abatement? If so, for how many years? How much each year and in total? Who is paying for roads, construction, and infrastructure for the data center? Will this result in a property tax increase due to road maintenance, infrastructure, added water lines, sewer lines, electric, buried fiber optic cables, street signs etc. Affordability is a concern for many struggling young families with children and senior citizens living on a pension or on social security. I moved here in part, due to affordability compared to other communities near by. Will this data center make the community less affordable for lower income families? Do citizens get an input, notice, or vote on whether or not the data center is built? We don't want our water bills or electric bills to increase, water table to be drained or polluted by wastewater. All of these things have happened in other communities that have allowed data centers. Will this be any different for Plainfield?</p> <p>Will our electric bills skyrocket thru Duke energy because of the massive amount of electricity being used 24 hours a day? Duke energy is notorious for having power failures and an inadequate power grid to meet the needs of Hendricks county citizens. How would this problem be addressed? Who will pay for improving the power grid to meet this new demand?</p> <p>This is not the best use of this land. Couldn't this land be better</p>

used for something that benefits many citizens, and not just one corporation?

How many long-term jobs will this create? Will it only employ a handful of people long-term? Will local citizens be hired for construction and employment at this Data Center, or will employees be brought in from other states? (as has happened in other areas that have a Data Center)

What is the net cost / net gain to the Plainfield community if the proposed Data Center is built?

Lastly, I am not in favor of this being built. I stand solidly against Artificial Intelligence on moral principal and integrity, and I hope that you will reconsider this proposal. I also hope that you will be more transparent about such plans that effect so many in the Plainfield and surrounding communities.
