Questions or Comments for the Town of Plainfield	<p>As a resident of Washington Township, who will live less than a mile away from the data center, I adamantly oppose a structure being built for a variety of reasons. Research shows that data centers pollute the air through emissions and infrared heat. Infrared heat is thermal which increases NOX and PM in the air. These directly correlate to lower air qualities and increased health problems in those who live close to them such as asthma, allergies, and some cancers. As someone who lives less than a mile away from the proposed data center I do not want my air quality to go down admissions should our children be objected to the emissions from a data center that brings little benefit to the community. Additionally, we do not have the infrastructure to continuously supply anywhere from 100,000 to 500,000,000 gallons of water required per day to cool the data center. The average household uses 60,000 gallons of water a year. So the daily usage of the data center would equate to approximately 36,500,000 to 1.82 trillion gallons of water per year depending on the square footage of the data centers. While the town may say the costs for water and power will not be offset by the towns people, other data centers that have been build have passed their costs to the constituents of the cities in which they have been built. Avon residence have a very high tax base and cannot continue to carry the burdens of tax exempt properties and businesses. The data center brings minimal positives to our community. The negative impact on our environment, health, cost-of-living, and general welfare far outweigh the positives.</p>
