Jain Temple



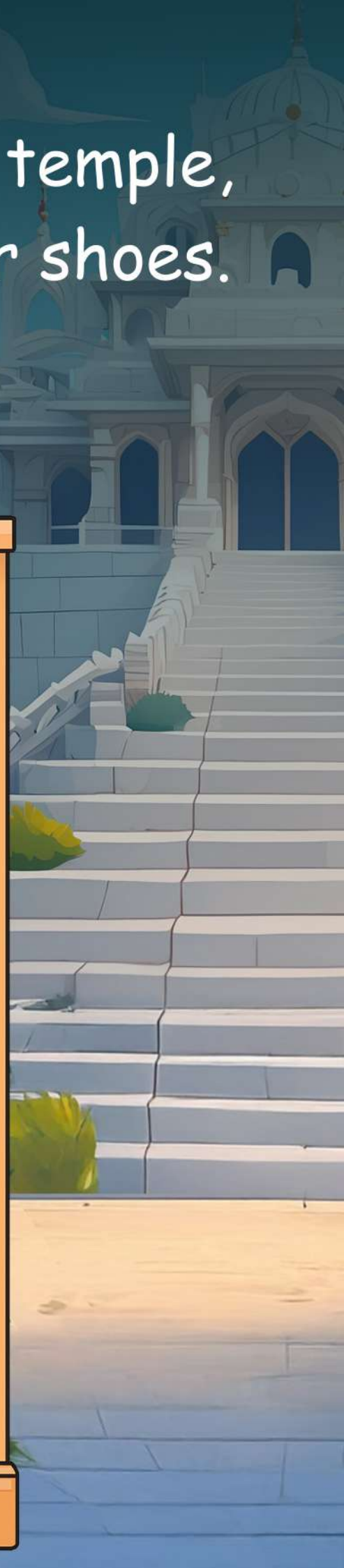
This is a Jain temple.

we must take off our shoes.



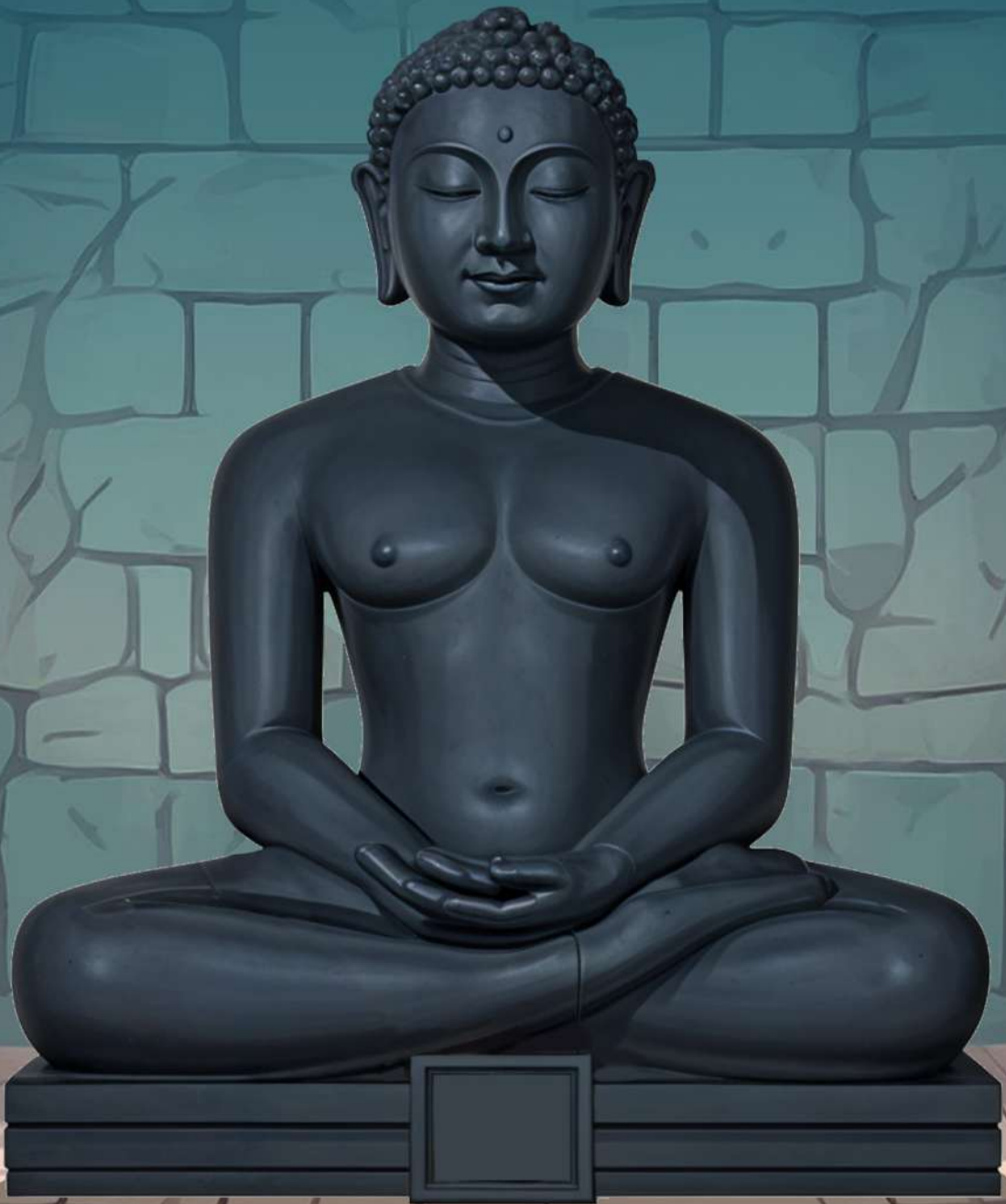
We do not eat, drink or

We pray to him quietly.



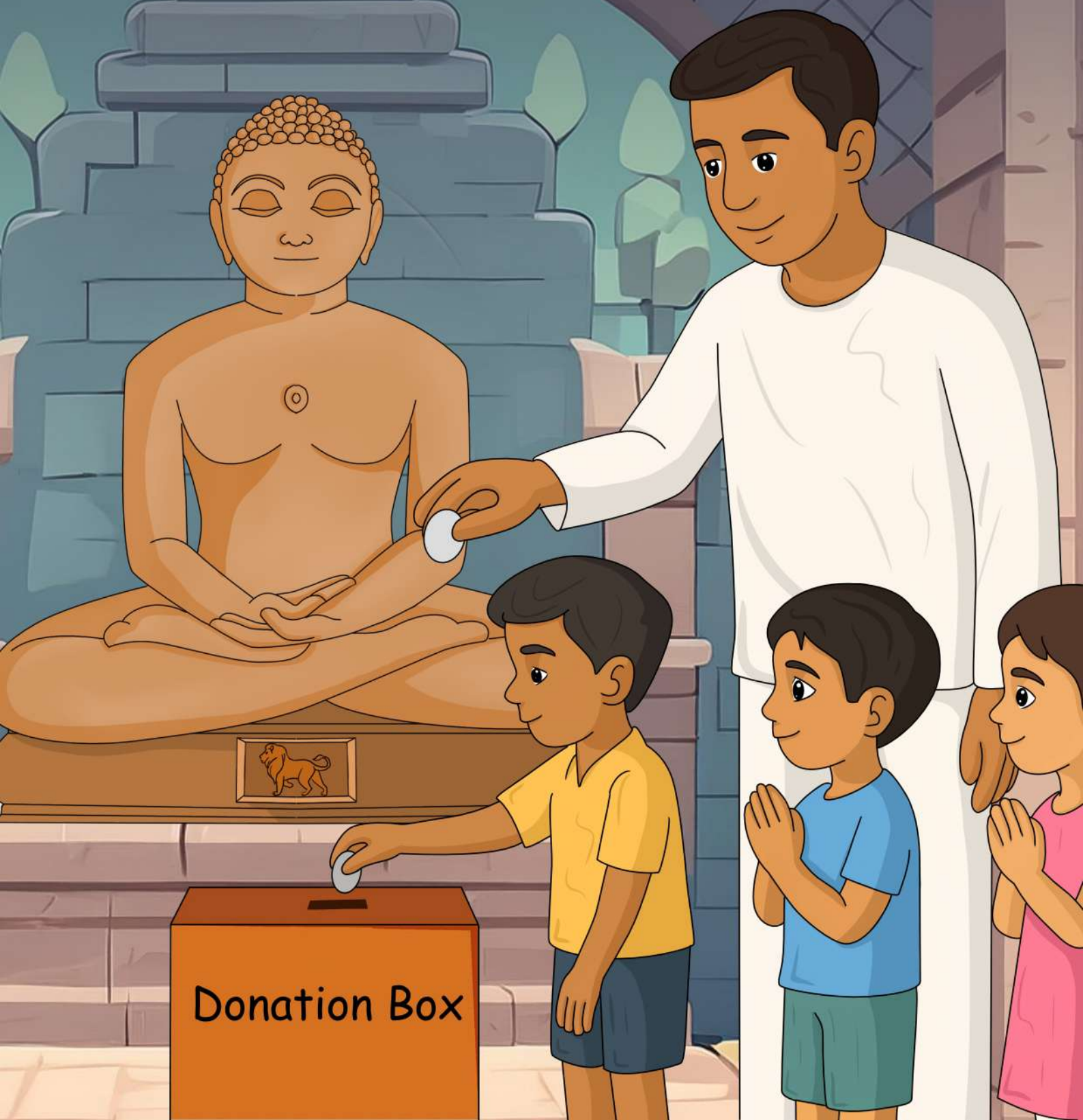
We sit down quietly and
