

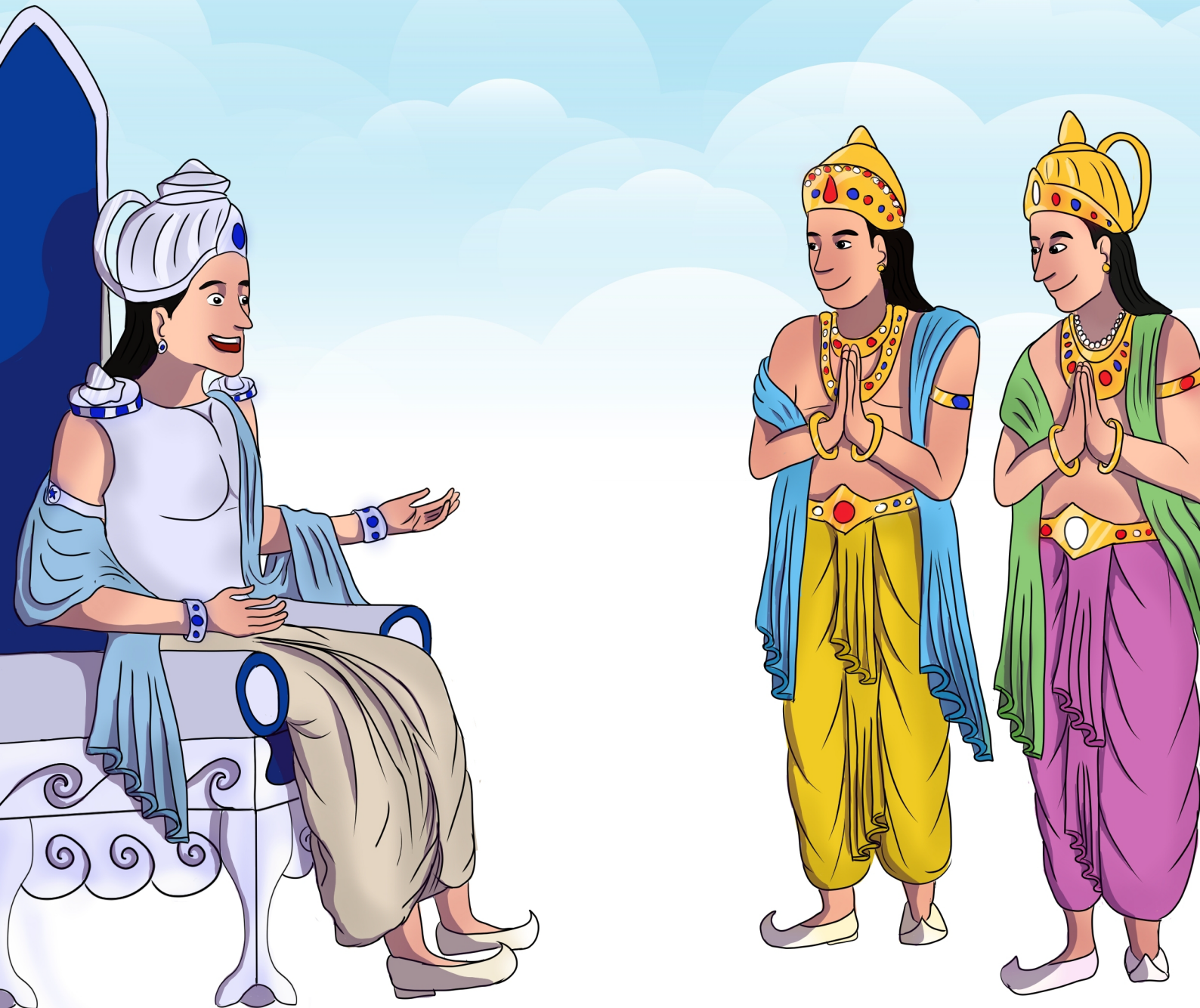
# The Caring Shree Krishna

Then, he held him close, wiped his wounds, and bandaged him. The God was very pleased to see how caring Shree Krishna is, and he appeared in his godly form.

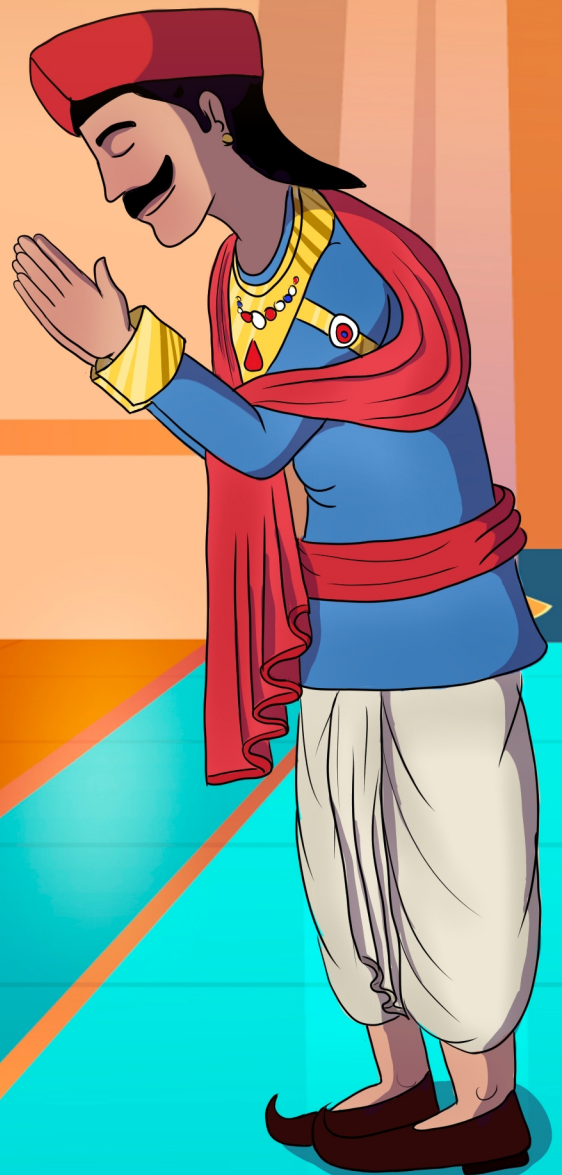


"Oh, Shree Krishna,"
