

The Good Student



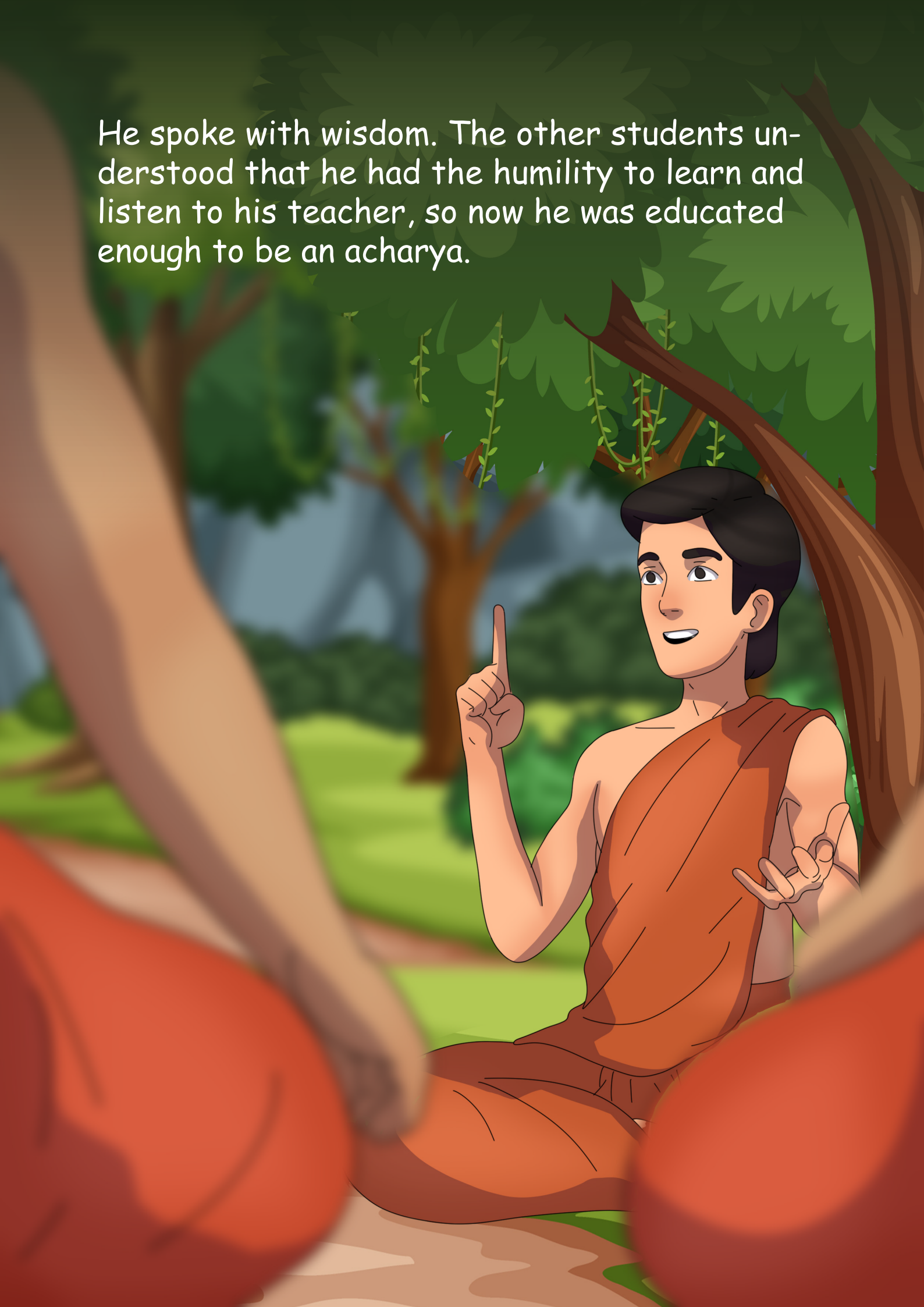
