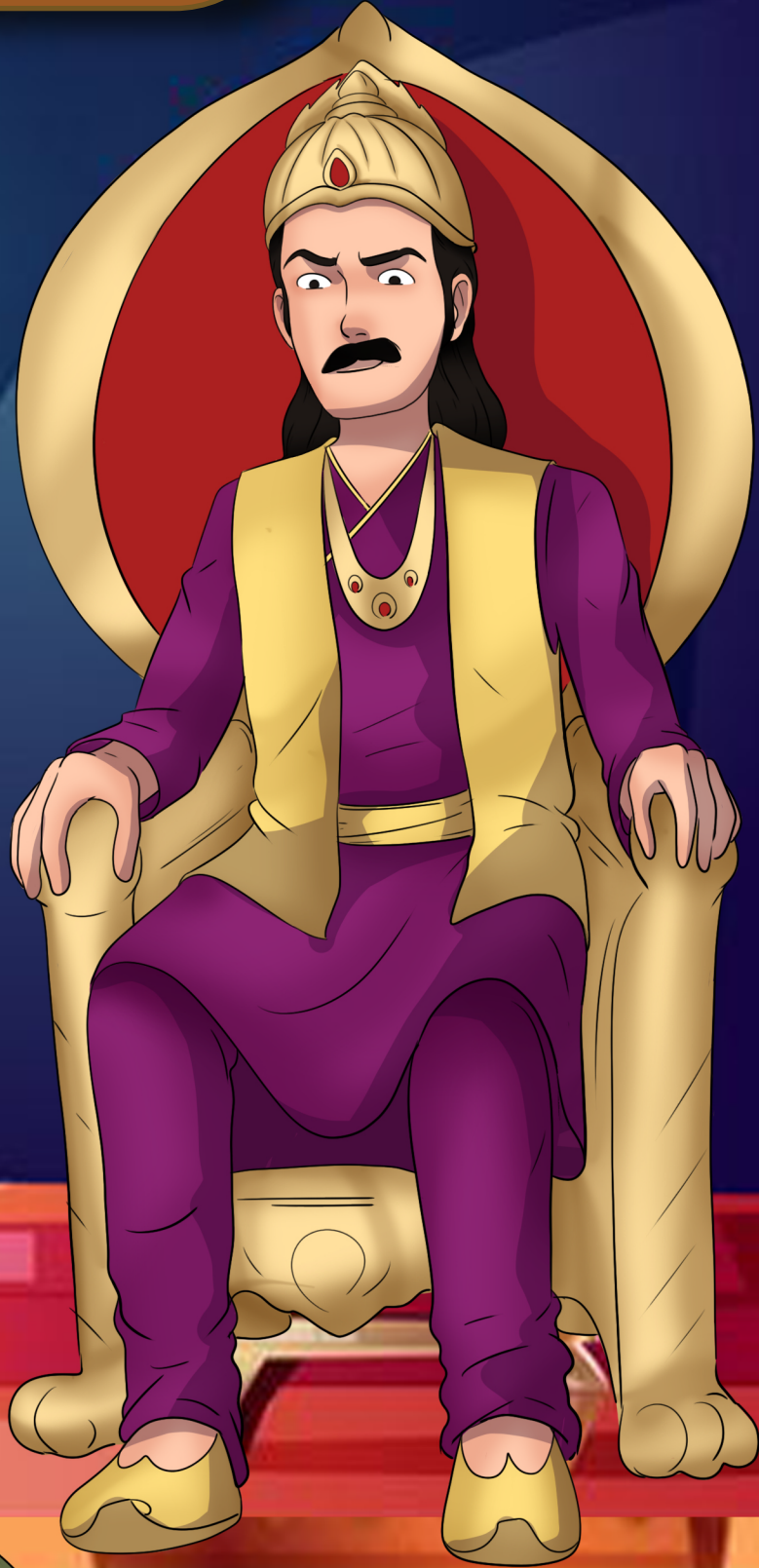


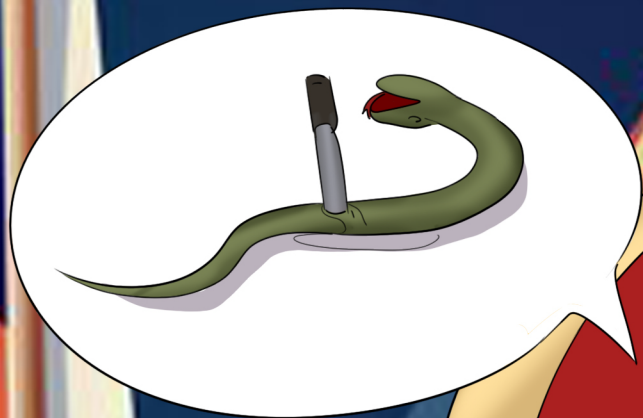
The Killing

The king was angry and ordered all the snakes in the kingdom to be killed. He offered a huge reward for it.



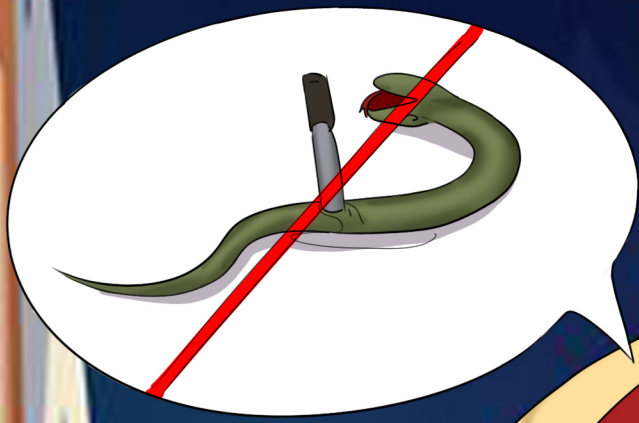
All the people, from the ministers to the beggars, began killing the snakes.
