She called her children and told them, "Stay inside the home. It is not safe outside. If you go outside, the farmer will catch you".

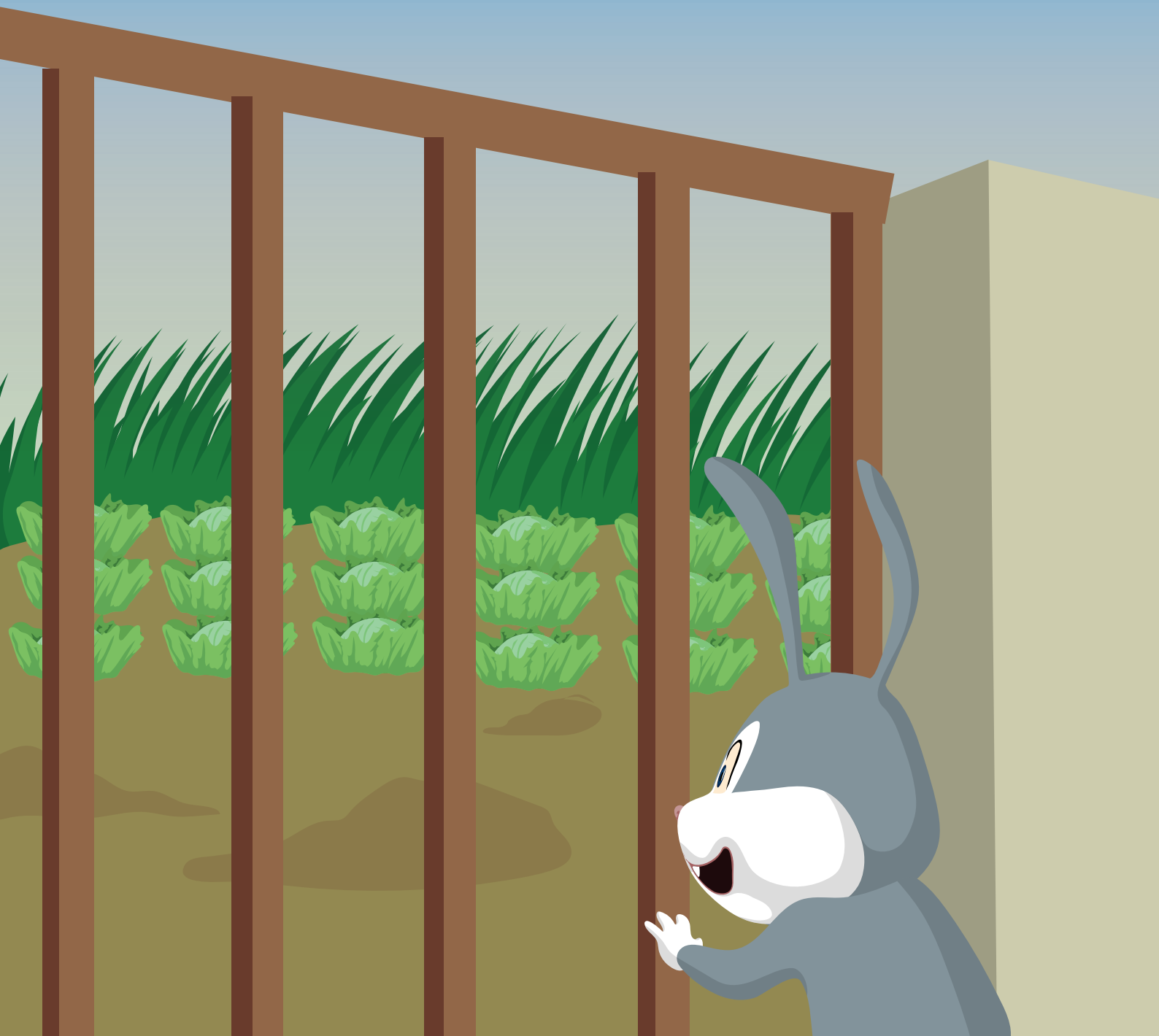
The little girls stayed at home, but Dolu, the naughty rabbit, went outside.

Poor Dolu! He wished he had listened to his mother.

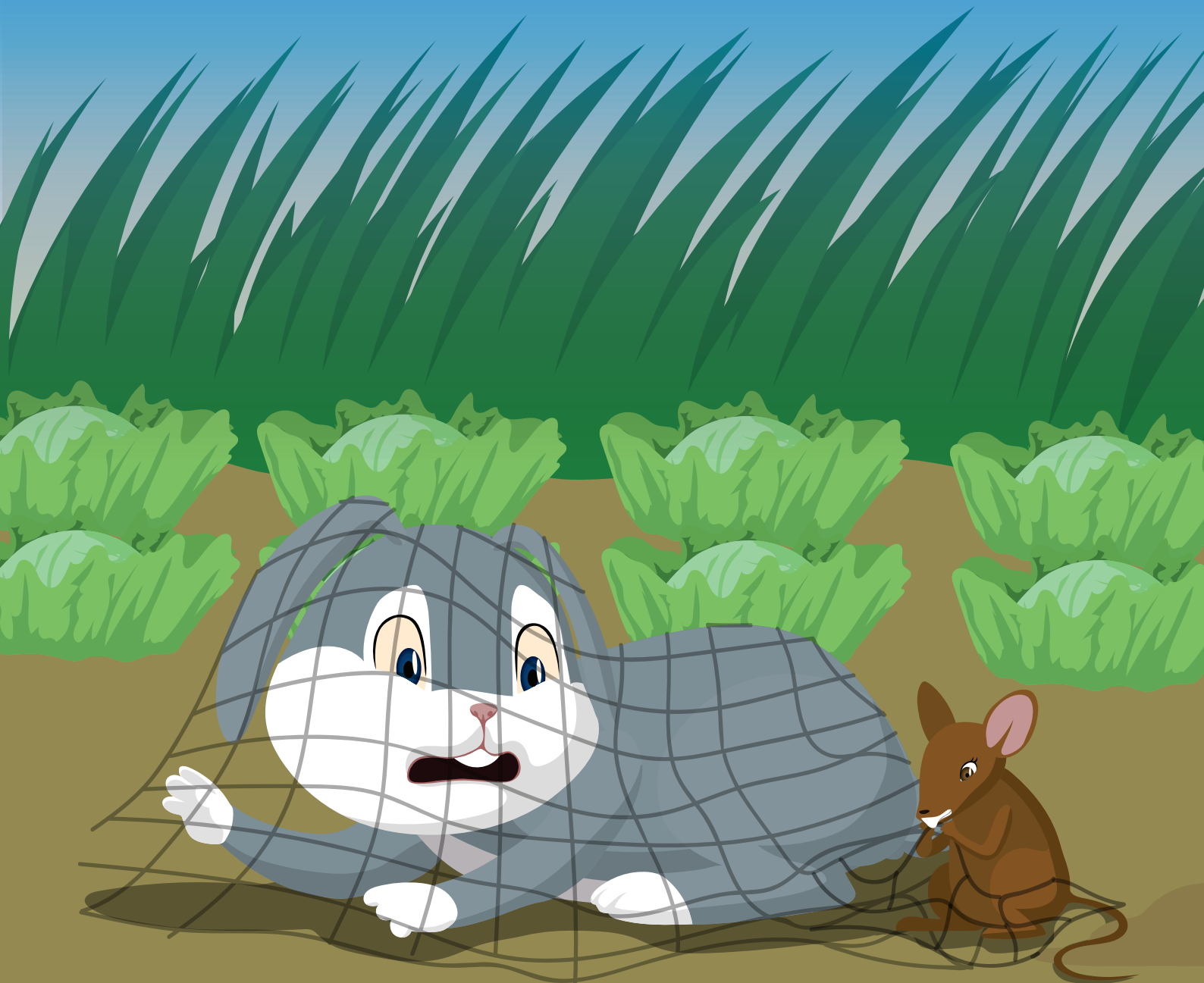


The farmer went inside to get a basket.
