The tiny village of Watervale (population of 246), nestled in South Australia's Clare Valley, is renowned for the quality of its Riesling.

Our Watervale Riesling is picked from a special part of the Florita vineyard in Watervale. This famous Riesling vineyard usually achieves full ripeness with high natural acid levels.

Wine has been flowing in the Clare Valley since 1851 and is an integral part of the culture. A small area, accounting for less than 1.5% of Australia's total wine production, it is one of Australia's most prestigious premium wine regions, most famous for its Riesling and Shiraz.

With its beautiful rolling hills, ideal winter rainfall, and Mediterranean climate, the Clare Valley carries a unique history and winemaking heritage.

Winemaking Notes

This wine displays a straw colour in the glass.

Aromas of citrus rind and brown lime, with a hint of rockmelon and floral notes.

On the palate, there is great citrus drive, with lemon and lime zest and grapefruit flavours.

A firm but fleshy line with a long finish of white florals and wet stone. A mouth watering, classic Watervale Riesling.
