Orientation

- > Invitation sent in April
- > Required, but not enforced
- > One day, one program
- > Lecture style
- > 75-100 per day
- > \$5 charge for lunch

Group advising @ Orientation

UNV 101 required (1sh)

- Graded
- > 30 students
- > Lack of interested faculty
- > Variations in quality, curriculum
- Service project(?)

Learning Communities

> 1/3 of FY students in clusters

Pre-Orientation Advising

- Required
- One-on-one with advisor
- > Parents/family encouraged to attend

Orientation

- Invitation sent in January
- > Required, enforced
- > 1.5 days
- Interactive, peer-led
- Capped at 50 per session
- Parent program

UNV 1010 required (1sh)

- Graded
- > 18 students
- > Standard curriculum & instructor training
- Required Service Learning = 10 hours
