Summer programs include outdoor Family Movie Nights, weekly online story times, and programs for exploring baking, creativity, and more! Participants can track reading progress online at *fondulaclibrary.beanstack.org* or on-the-go with the Beanstack app. Paper reading logs are also available at the library or can be printed from fondulaclibrary.org.

Also starting June 1, the library's new hours will be 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday; 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Fridays, and 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturdays. Study rooms, additional seating, public bathrooms, newspapers, and the ongoing book sale will return, as well. Face masks remain required for all patrons ages two and older and library staff members.
