

Eagle Watching in Grafton



January brings the start of Eagle season in Grafton and there are several options for you to view one of nature's most majestic birds in the area.

Greater Rivers and Routes of Alton will be offering bus tours that leave from the Grafton Visitors Center every Saturday in January starting on Jan. 8. The tours start at 8am and 2:30pm and leave from the parking lot of the Visitors Center, the cost is \$23.00 per person. This two-hour tour will highlight sites where wintering American Bald eagles are typically seen in the area. Sites will include: the Brussels Ferry, Calhoun Point, and Pere Marquette State Park. https://www.riversandroutes.com/things-to-do/buy-tickets/

On January 15 and 29 there will be a live eagle Meet and Greet at the Visitors Center from 10am to 2pm with an eagle from the World Bird Sanctuary. See an eagle up close and personal and find out more about this once endangered bird.

Take your own scenic drive up the River Rd where you can spot eagles from your car along the riverbank, out on the ice or flying high up above the bluffs, then warm up in Grafton at one of the local bars & grills with a hot meal and one of your favorite beverages.


