1 The federal government has spent over \$3 trillion to help the economy recover from the pandemic and government shutdowns. Because of the growing federal debt, a proposal has been made to stop all new federal spending. Would you favor or oppose this proposal?*

2 Government orders forced many businesses to shut down. A proposal has been made for the government to reimburse companies for losses resulting from the shutdown. The funds would be used to retain or rehire employees impacted by the shutdown. Would you favor or oppose this proposal?*

3 State and local governments have lost significant tax revenue due to the coronavirus and the business shutdowns. A proposal has been made for the federal government to replace those lost revenues and preserve government jobs. Would you favor or oppose this proposal?*

Methodology

The survey of 1,200 Registered Voters was conducted by Scott Rasmussen using a mixed mode approach from June 18-20, 2020. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Most respondents were contacted online while 210 were contacted using automated phone polling techniques. Certain quotas were applied to the overall sample and lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.
