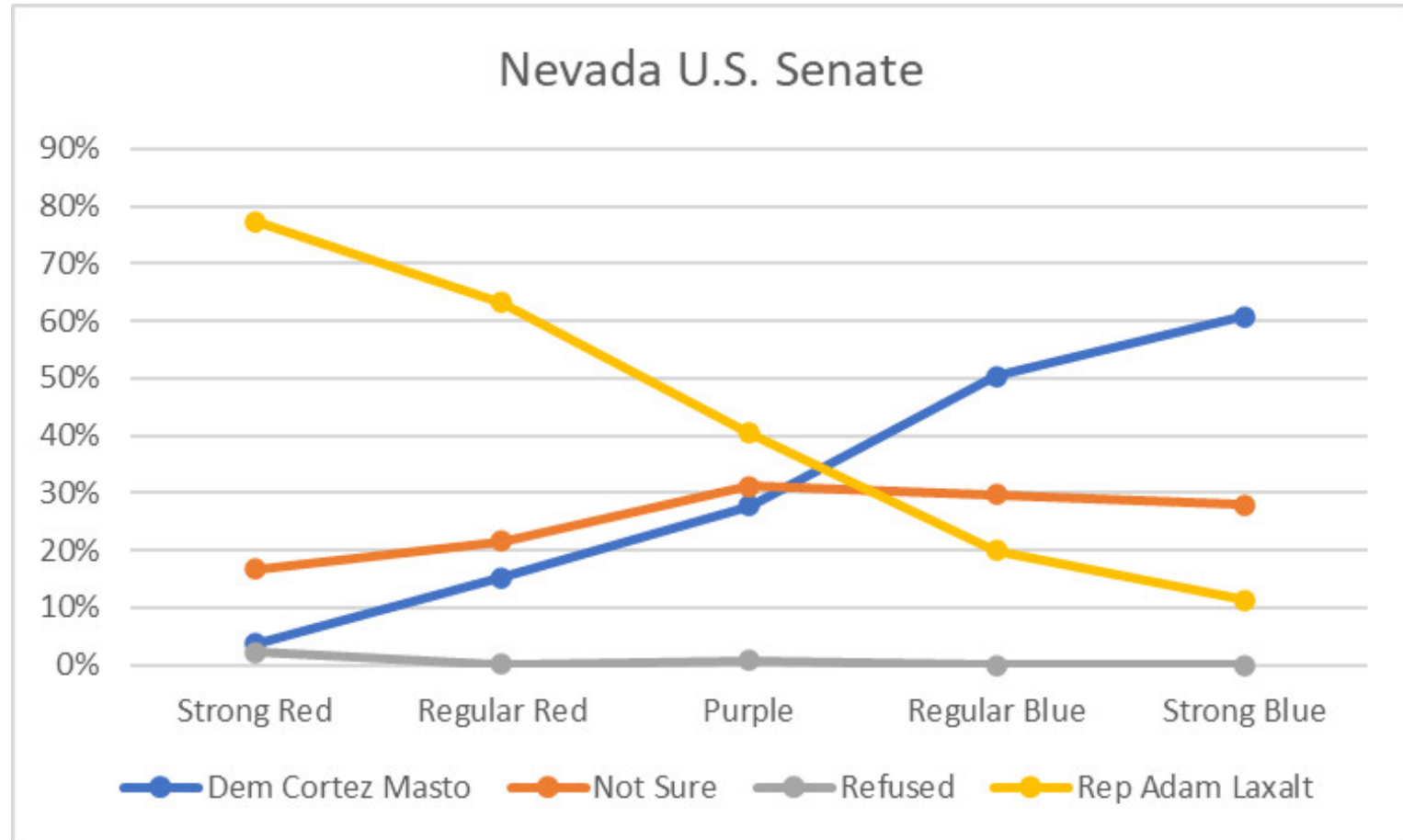
How to Read These Results

Strong Red= High consumer correlation to a strong Republican Trump Voter

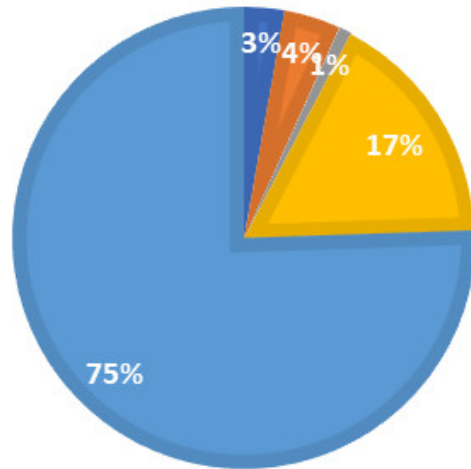
Strong Blue= High consumer correlation to Democrat who strenuously opposed Trump



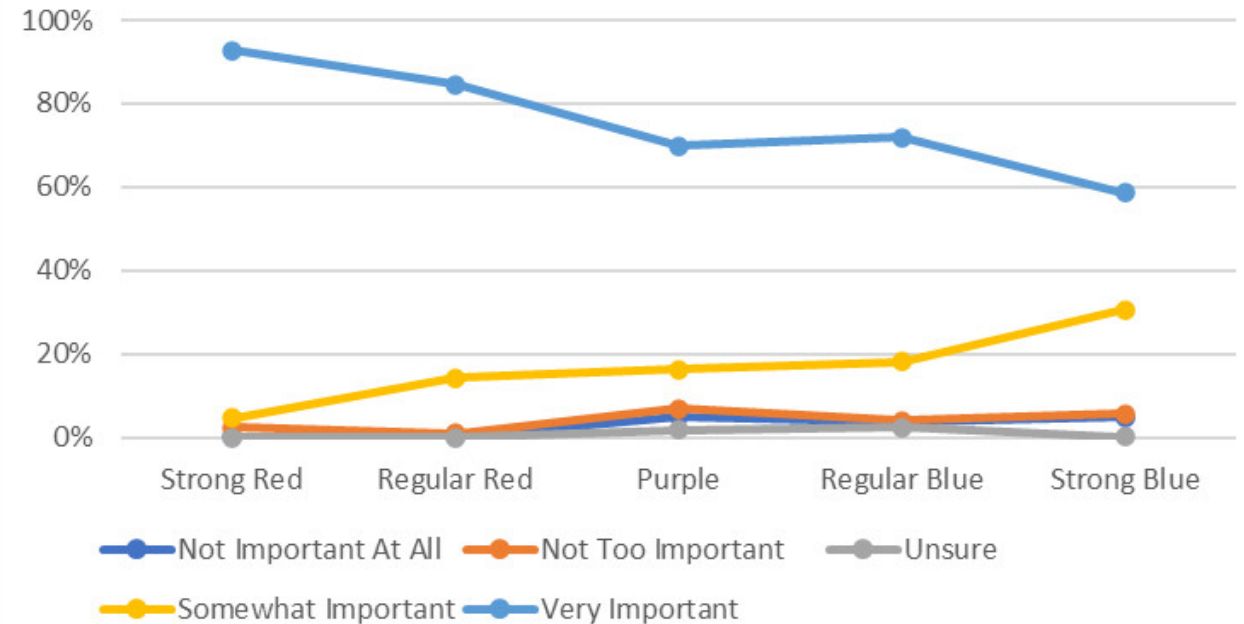
Thinking of some of the top issues that politicians need to address, how important is controlling inflation that is causing the prices of groceries, cars and gas to go up?

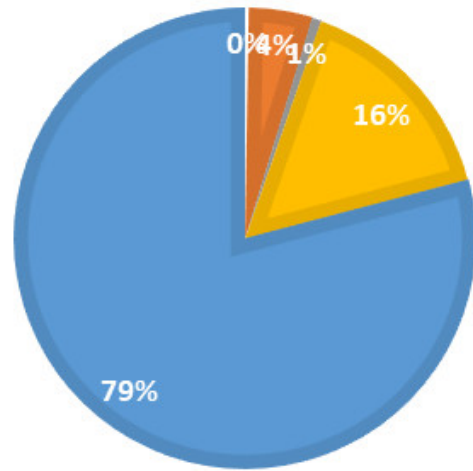

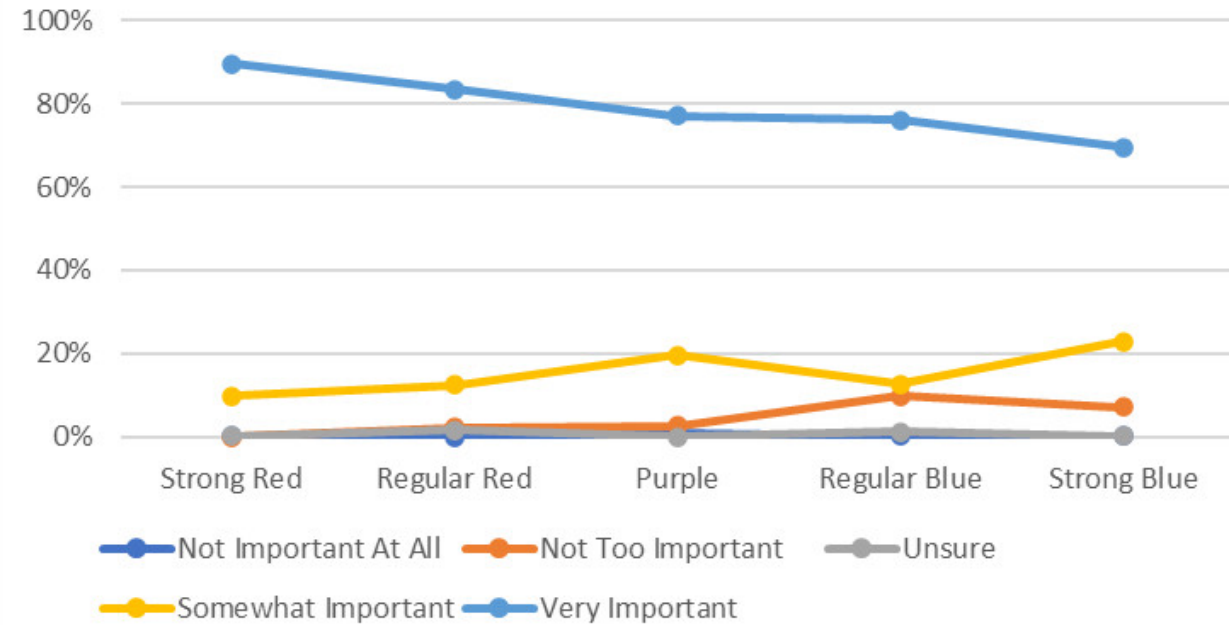
How important is stopping the increase in violent crime?

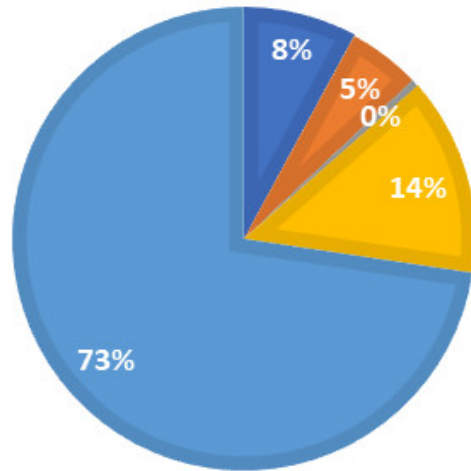

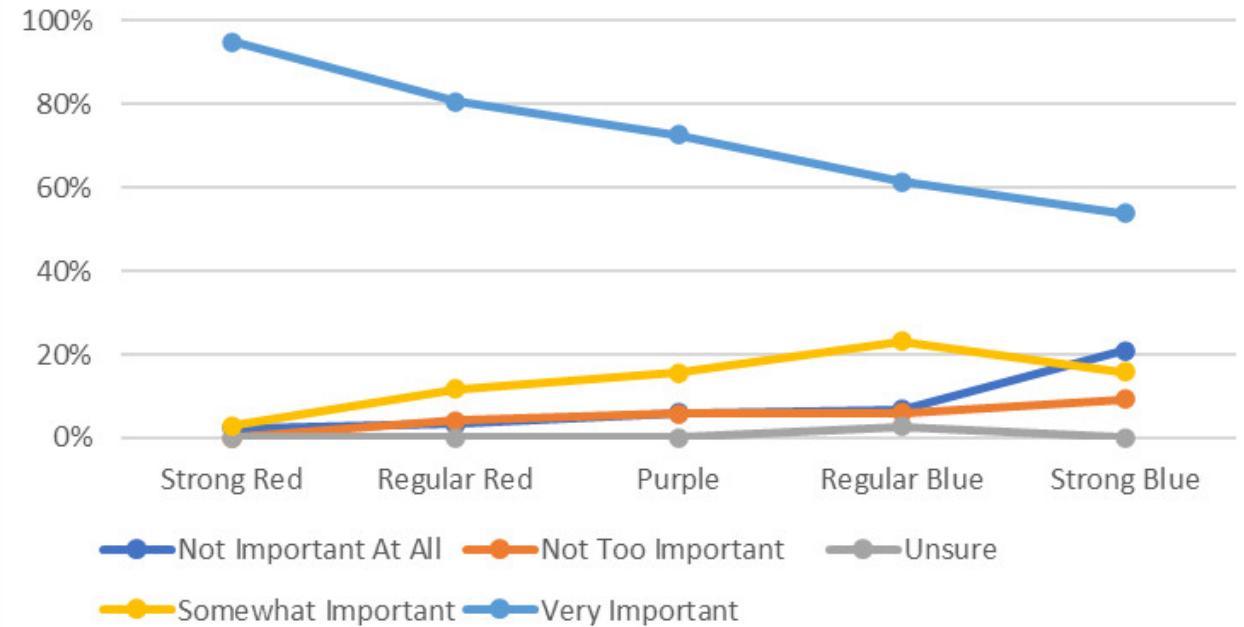
How important is election security to prevent voter fraud?

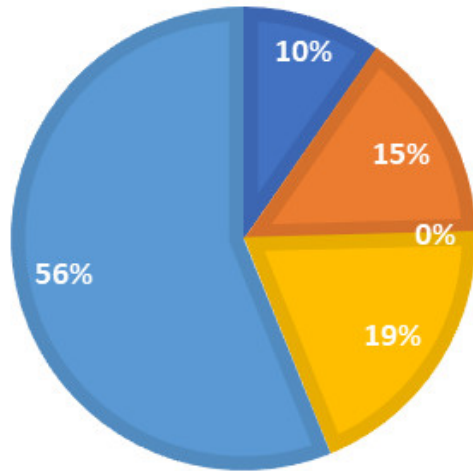

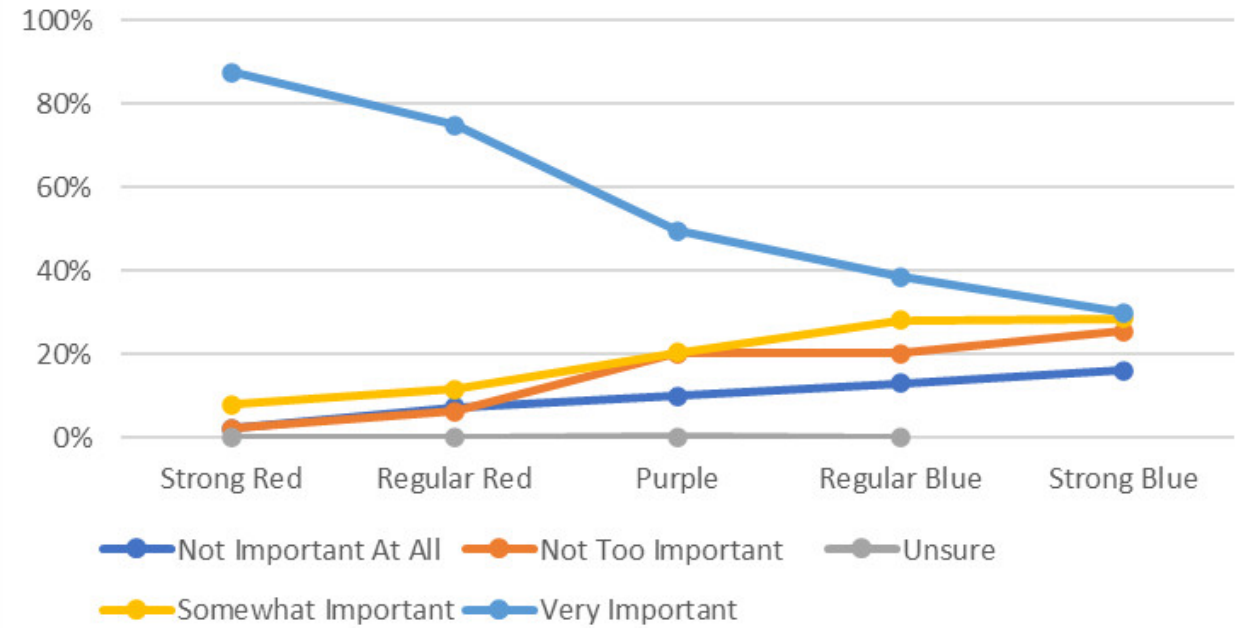
How important is securing the United States' Border with Mexico?

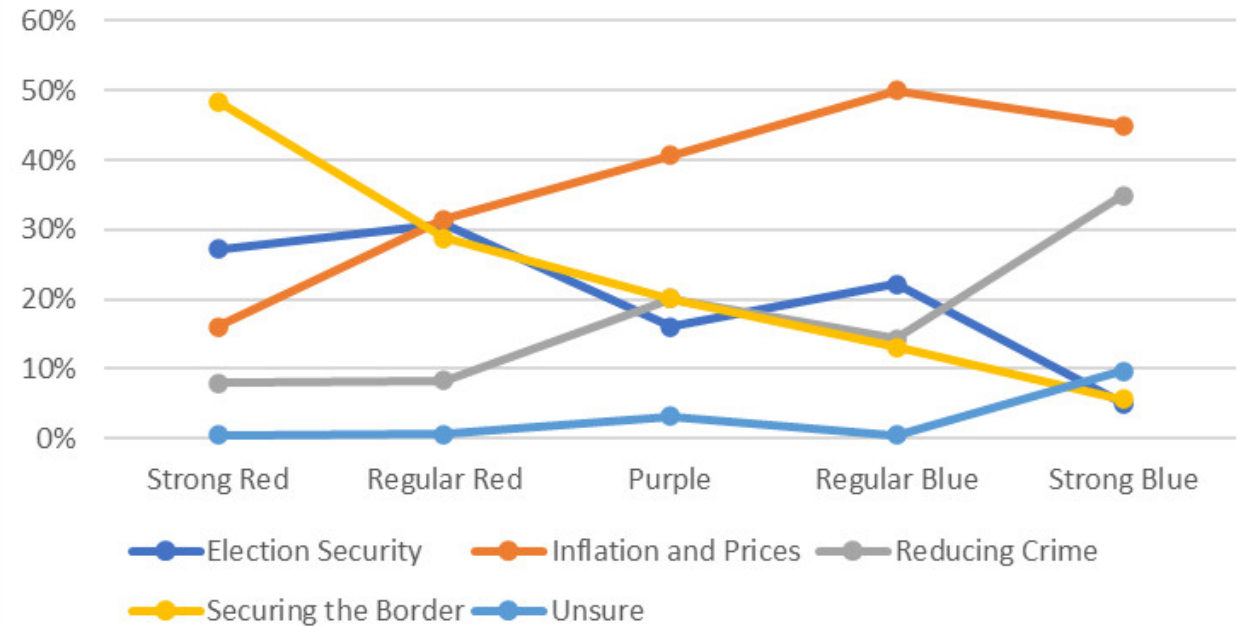

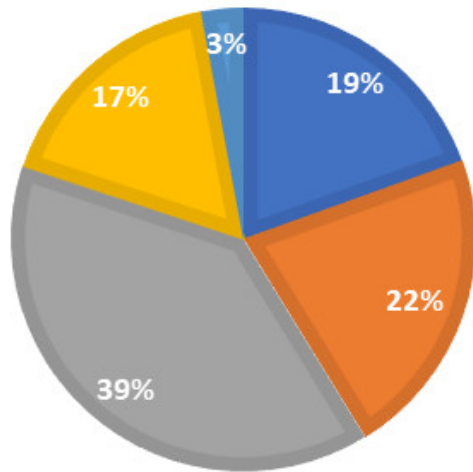

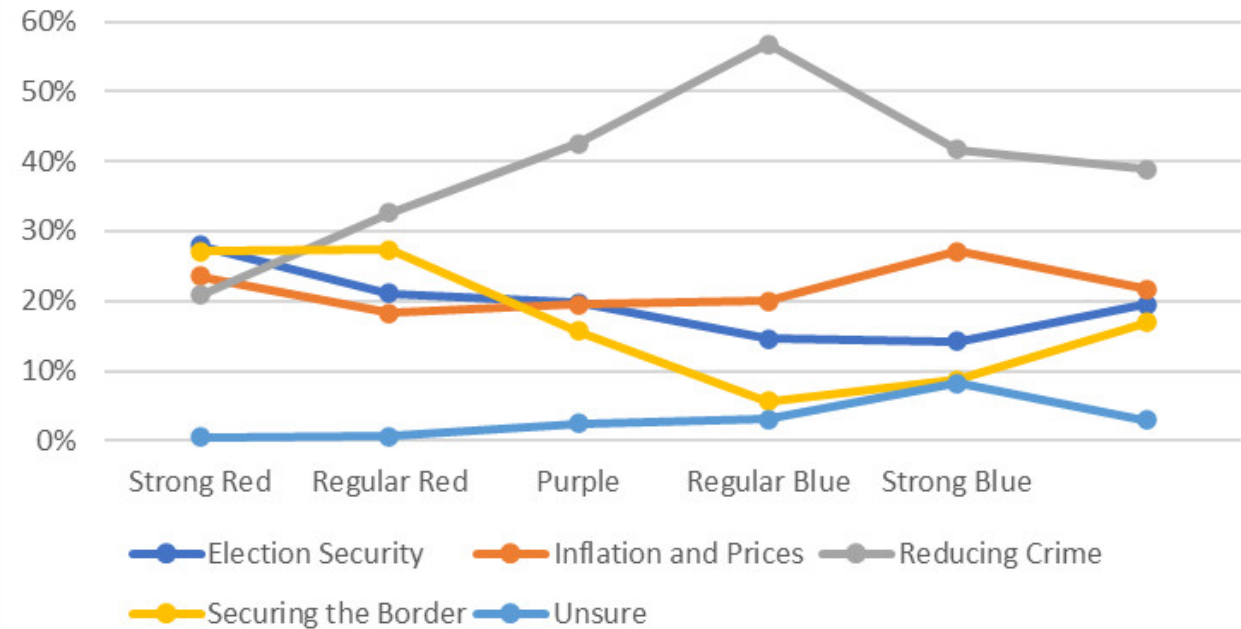

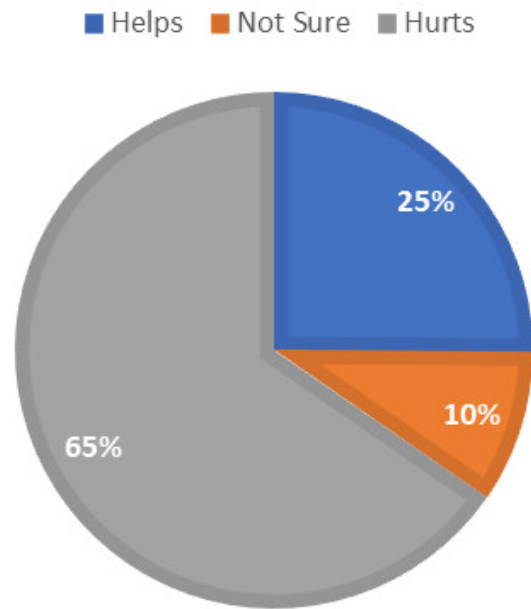

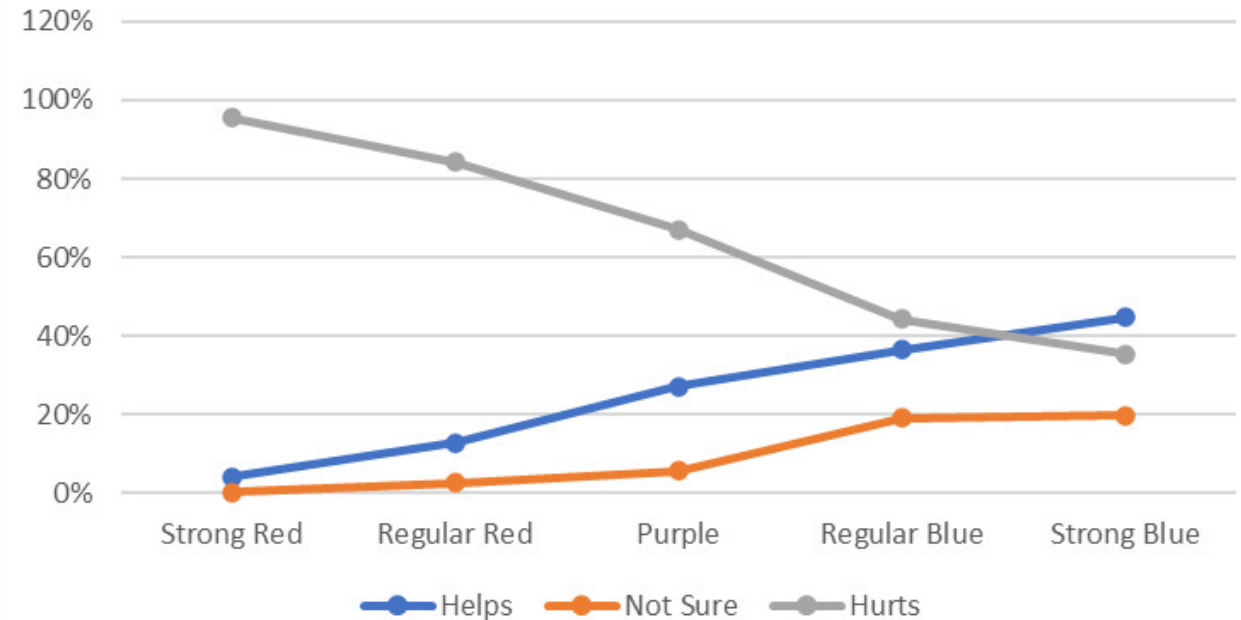

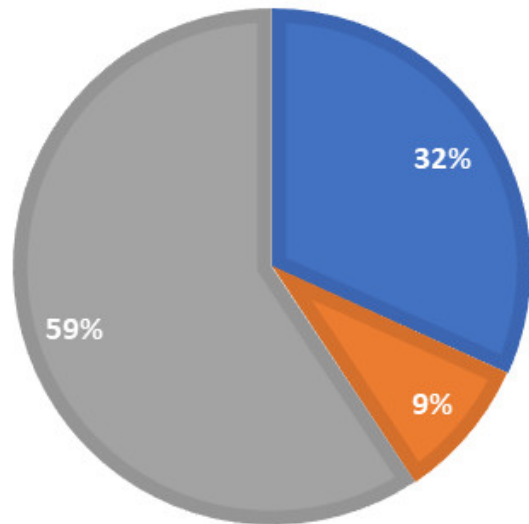

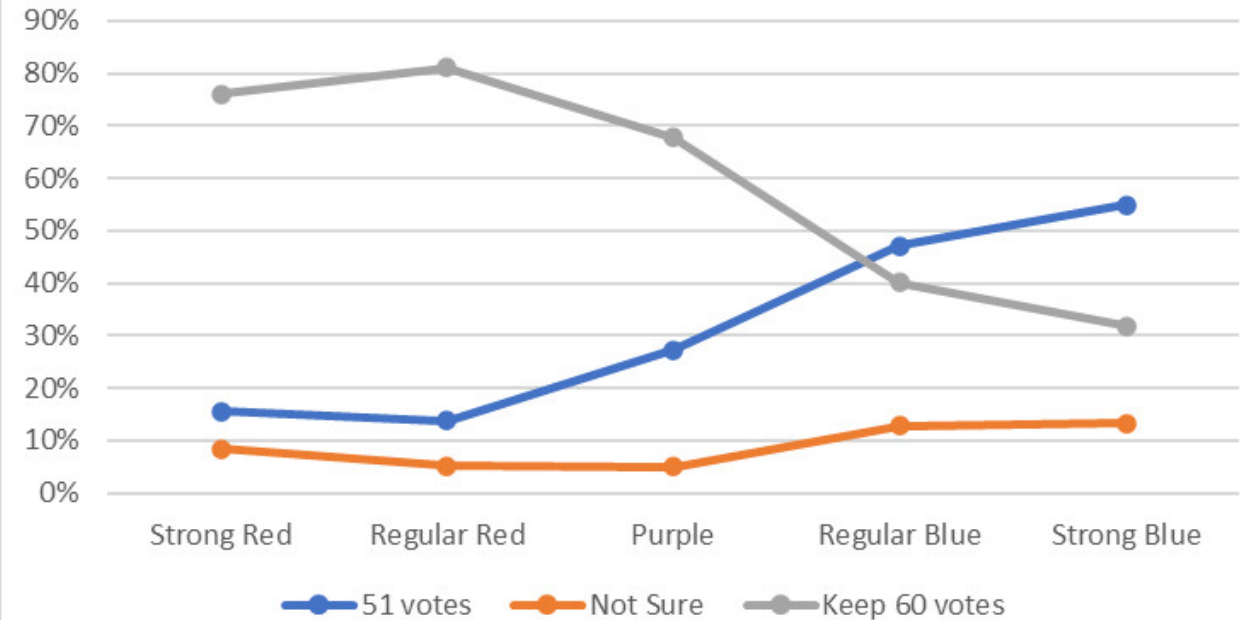

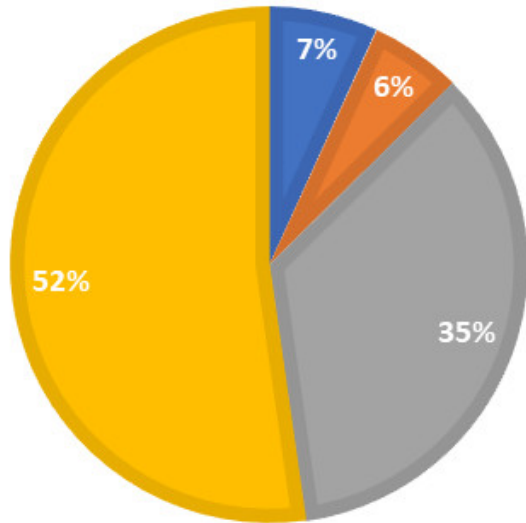

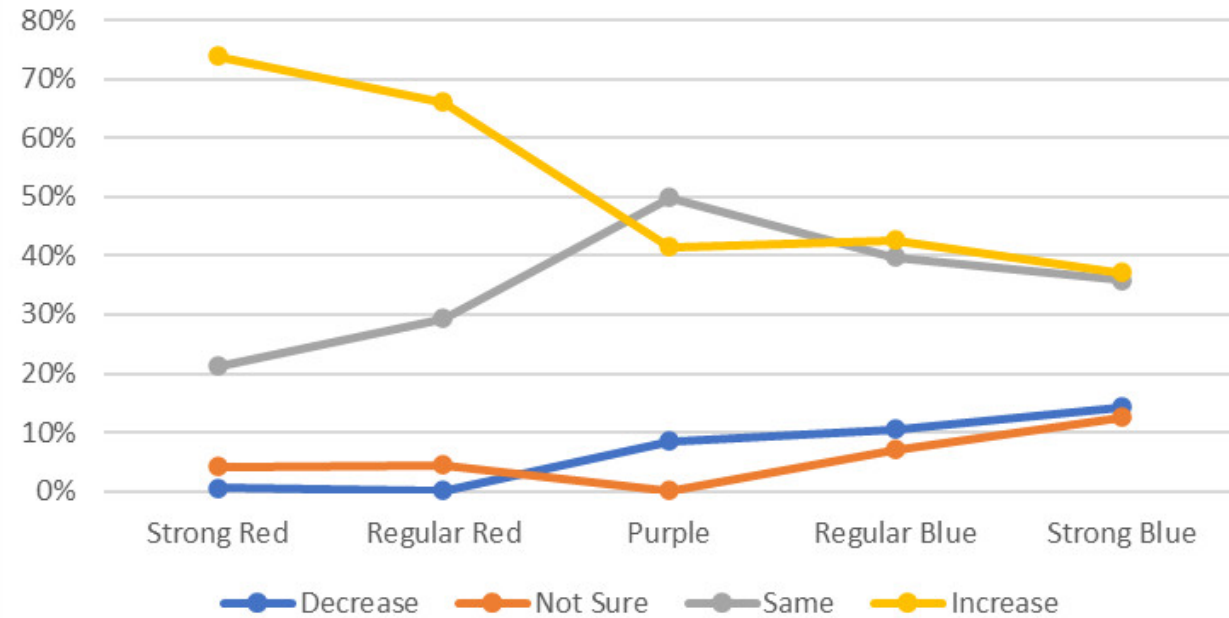
Thinking about Nevada --- in general, should spending on police and law enforcement in be increased, decreased or stay about the same?

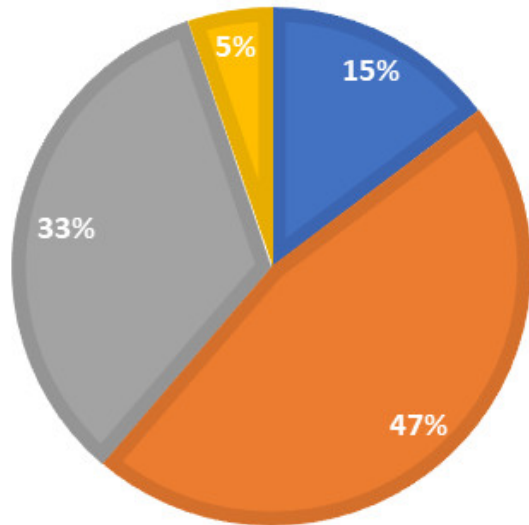

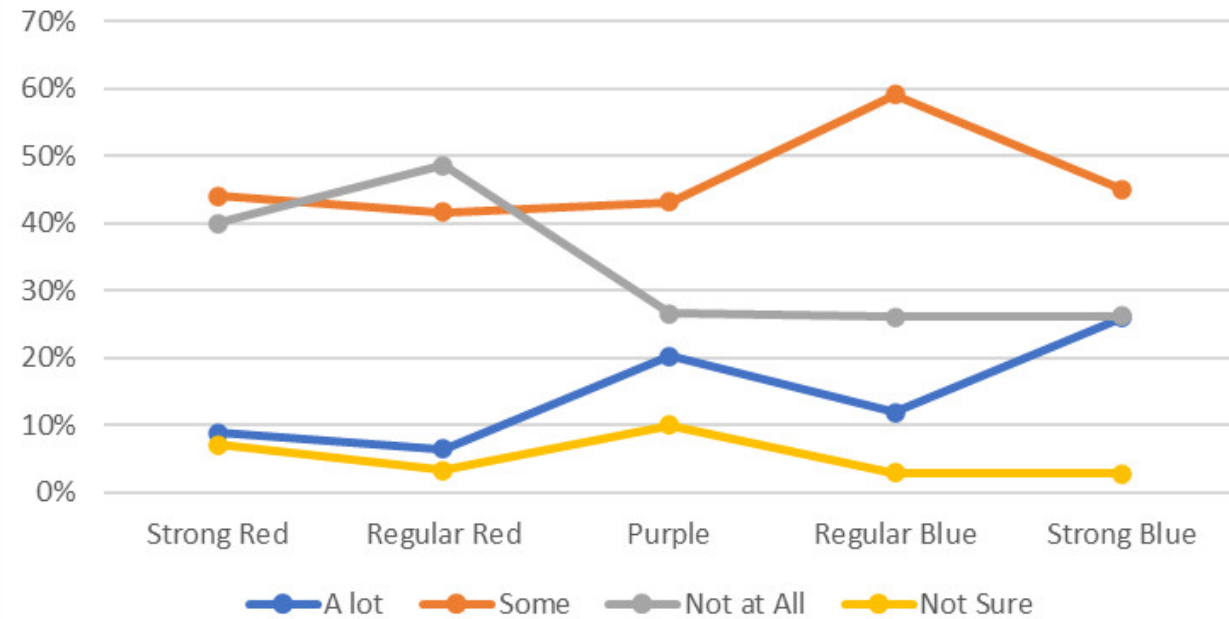
Thinking about the trillions of dollars in various Government COVID stimulus, how much have you Directly benefitted from those spending programs?

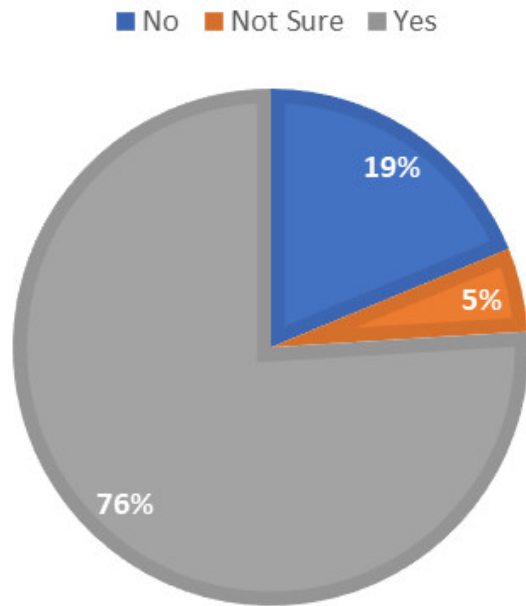

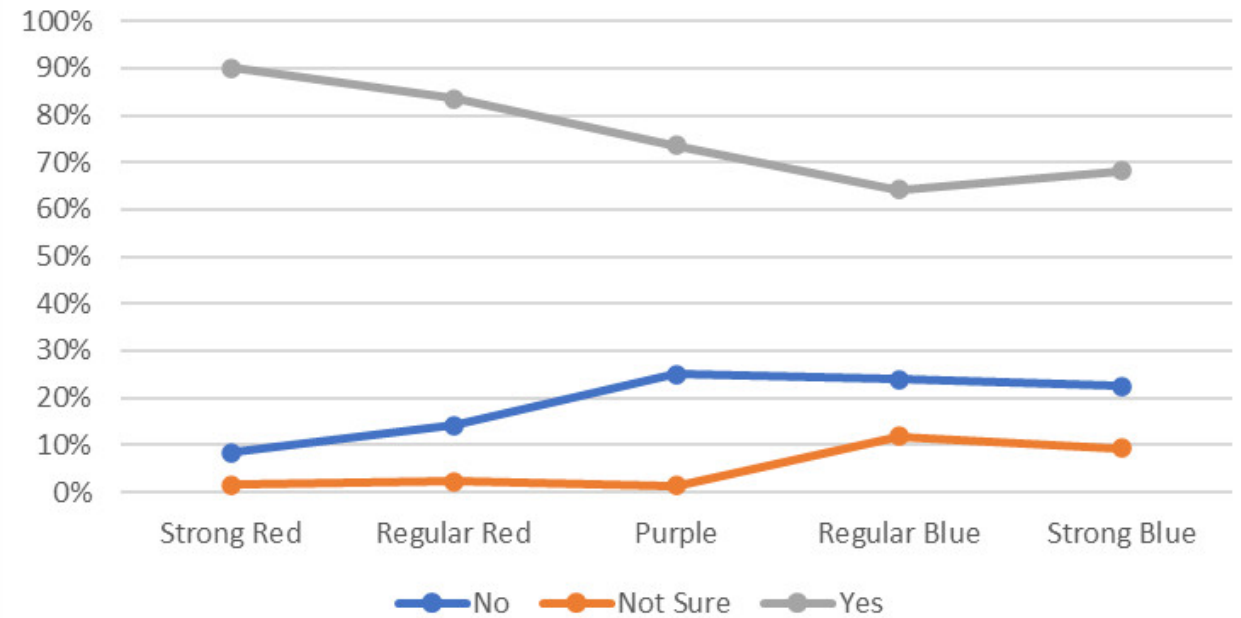


Does the increase in violent crime hurt economic growth and jobs?

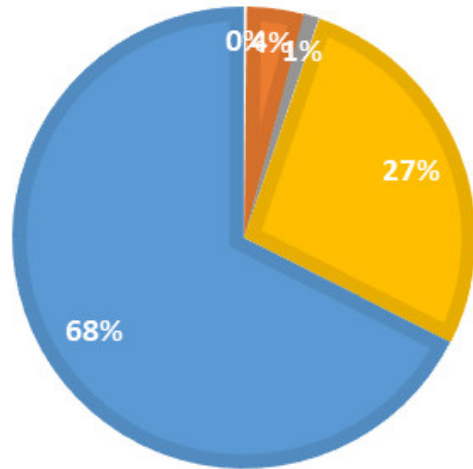

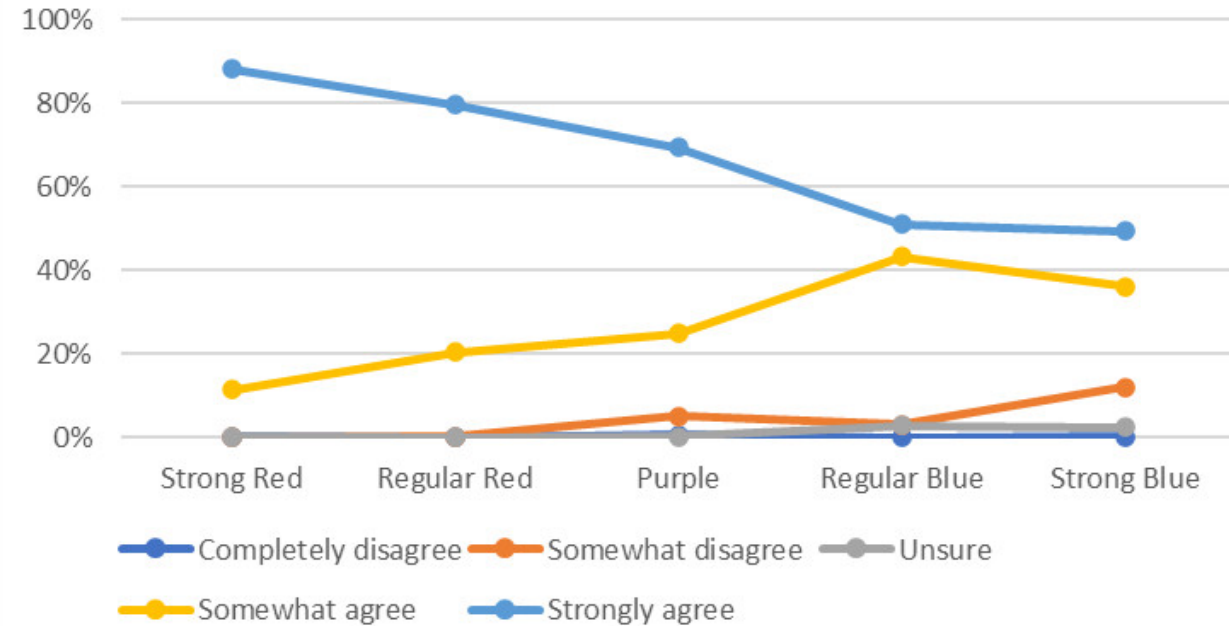

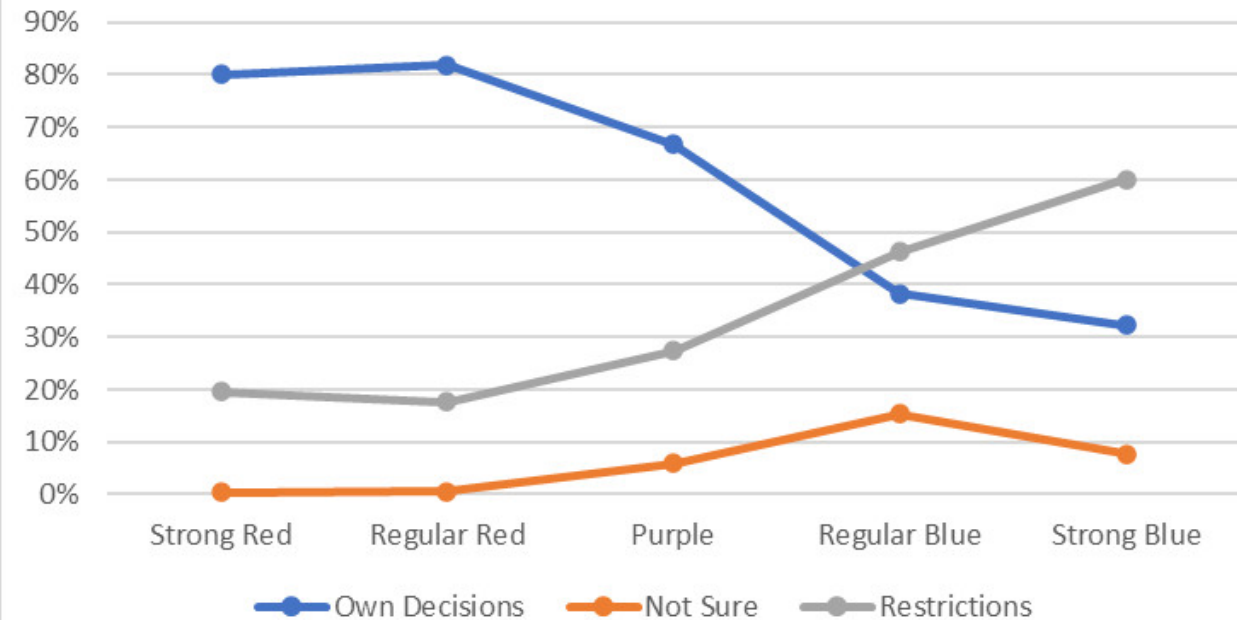

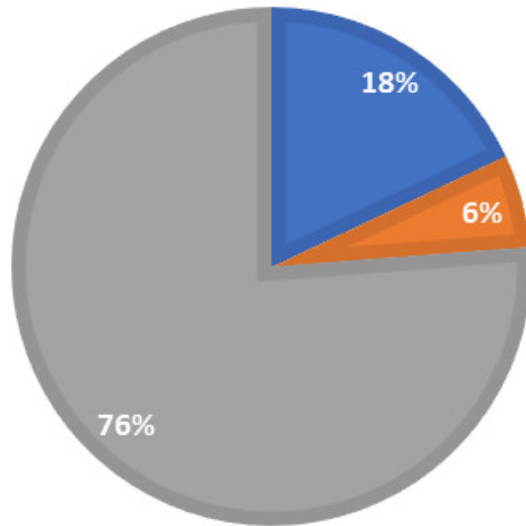

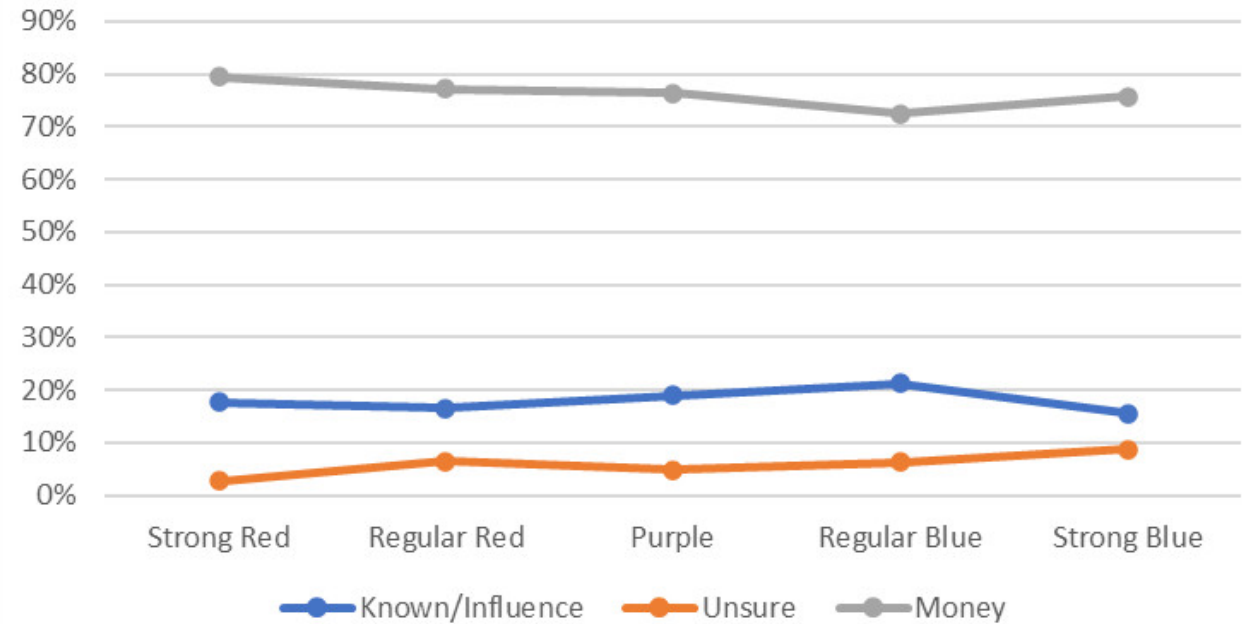

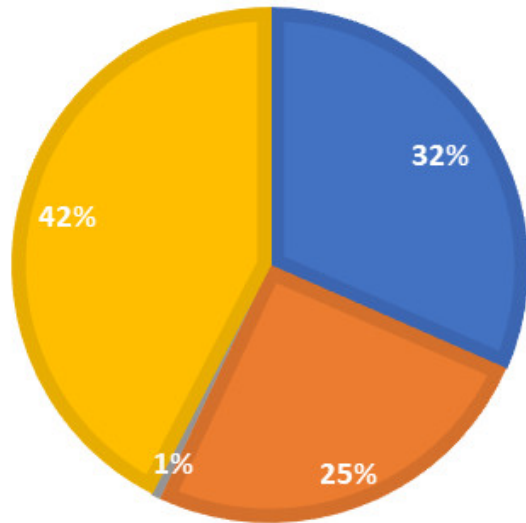
