A total of 72,483 job openings were posted online from October 14, 2021, through November 13, 2021, for Delaware, Fairfield, Franklin, Knox, Licking, Logan, Madison, Marion, Morrow, Pickaway and Union counties. This was an increase of 1,859 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflects an increase of 22,015 ads. The graph below shows historical trends for ads posted in this area over the last several years.

Seasonal variations can also affect the number of online job ads, so over the year it will affect the data in this report.
