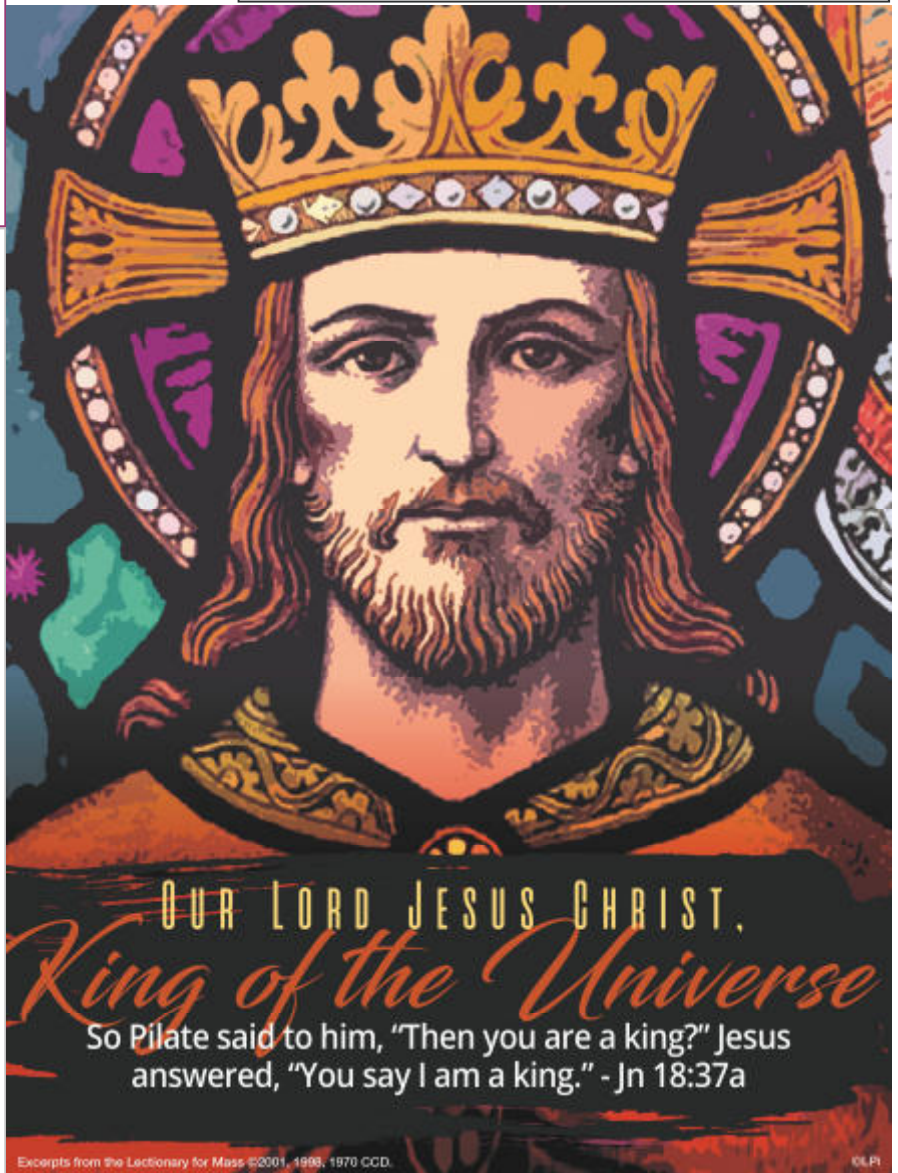

WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Question:

Why do we make changes in the Mass? Some seem so small and unimportant. Are they really necessary?

Answer:

The celebration of the Eucharist is at the heart of our identity as Catholics. Our purpose as a Church community revolves around the Eucharist. Everything we are and everything we do is measured not only by how well we celebrate, but also by how well we live the sacrament. If that is so, then we as a community will always strive to celebrate the Mass as best we can. The reasons for some changes might seem more obvious than others, but there is a reason behind each one.

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal is the introduction to the Missal that contains all the prayers for the celebration of the Mass. The Order of Mass we use now was issued in 1975 and, as often happens over the course of years, some questions have come up about the proper way of doing some things and whether or not other practices are acceptable. These changes clarify some things and make the celebration of the Mass more meaningful for everyone.

The opportunity is presented to us to better learn and understand each part of the Mass, which in turn should help us deepen our appreciation for its beauty and meaning. We will be a better Church if we have a clearer understanding and knowledge of Who and what we celebrate. @LPi

SAINT OF THE WEEK – EXAMPLES OF OUR FAITH

St. Francesco Antonio Fasani | Feast Day November 27

St. Francesco Antonio Fasani (1681 – 1742) lived his whole life as a loving, devout, and atoning man. He entered the Conventual Franciscans in 1695, and 10 years later taught philosophy to younger friars, served as guardian of his friary, and eventually became provincial minister. When his term of office ended, St. Francesco became master of novices and finally pastor in his hometown of Lucera. Known throughout his various ministries as being loving, devout, and penitential, he was also a well-known confessor and preacher. St. Francesco was a loyal friend of the poor and worked tirelessly to find ways to support them. He was a mystic with such a profound prayer life and supernatural gifts that he was known to levitate during prayer. He was canonized in 1986 by Pope John Paul II. ©LPi

The Supreme Court case *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* could impact the fate of millions of preborn children and their mothers by overturning *Roe v. Wade*, the Supreme Court decision that legalized abortion. Pray that the Justices will not be persuaded by political pressure or perceived public opinion, but that they would be impartial in their judgment. Oral arguments begin Wednesday, December 1; a decision will be announced by June 22, 2022. Here are some things you can do to help:

- Register at www.prayfordobbs.com to join together in continued prayer and stay informed on the case.
 - Encourage others to register and pray.
 - Choose a time during the day (example: 3:00 p.m.) to say a prayer for the case and for the moms and babies.
 - Fast once a week (food, television, etc.) for the cause.
 - Use the social media images and fliers on the website to inform others and share weekly reminders.
 - Ask leaders of parish organizations and ministries to include prayer for the Dobbs case in meetings and events.
 - Join the special 40 Days for Life 365 prayer vigil on November 30 and December 1 anytime between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. in front of Planned Parenthood in Sarasota or 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. in Fort Myers.
