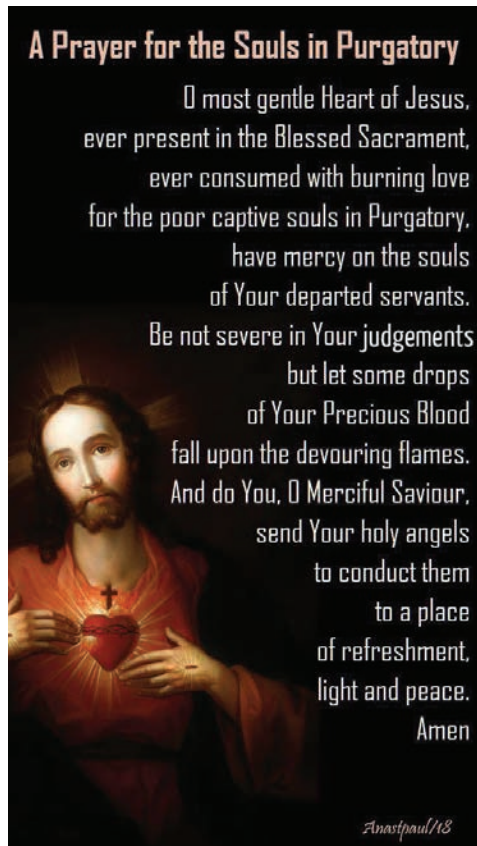

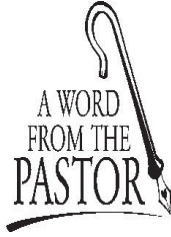

DON'T FORGET TO REMEMBER

A practice that I have always tried to follow has been to carefully look at all the names parishioners write down for remembrance at the Altar during November, the month during which we pray for the dead in a special way. I do this because the priest has a special obligation to pray for his people and to carefully fulfill their wishes, especially in this matter of praying for the dead. However, there is another reason: in reading the names and the things that people write, I am having a sermon preached to me! It is a sermon, which sets forth several points, which I would like to share with you:

- You do not “forget.” In some cases, your beloved dead may be gone for many years, but you do not fail to remember them and all that they meant to you. In a world in which people often forget those who have helped them, this is a tribute in itself.
- It is a great act of humility to remember our dead. We recall who we came from and the good influences that have gone into making us who we are.
- In remembering your dead, you acknowledge not only ties of blood but also those that come from affection or marriage. This recalls to us the marvel of God creating us to live in a human society, with all the mutual support that should go with that. These are the ties, built into our human nature, that should provide what no government or program can ever give.
- The more we turn in on ourselves and give in to that selfishness, which is a part of our fallen nature and particularly a part of modern society, we forget others. In remembering our dead, we turn outward and in consequence work against that selfish tendency.

- There is a part of human nature, which desires to “do good to those who can do good for us.” Praying for the dead is the exact opposite of being an “operator” or a “user.” Except, of course, in the spiritual order, in which those we help to get to Heaven by our prayers will help us here on earth.
- There is what amounts to a very self-serving tendency today, in which we presume that everyone immediately goes to Heaven! It is self-serving because it excludes from our minds the seemingly unpleasant thoughts of judgment and personal responsibility. Those who remember to pray for their beloved dead not only unite themselves to those who have gone before them but also continue to show them true affection by praying for them.

Yes, praying for the dead is a “holy and wholesome thought” as we read in the Book of Maccabees. Our belief in a place called Purgatory acknowledges that some of us, and some of those who have gone before us in death, may be in need of further purification after death. Praying for those who have died reminds us of this teaching and continues to unite us to our beloved, who have gone before us in death.

This has been a summary of the sermon that is preached to me as I go through those lists of names! I hope you do not mind my sharing it with you.

Bee Bots Invade Holy Rosary

Holy Rosary's Innovation Lab continues to evolve! Last year we shared with you the news of the Sphero programmable robots that the upper grades were utilizing to sharpen their coding skills. A few weeks ago, twenty-four *Bee Bots* swarmed our lab. *Bee Bots* are digital technologies that are the size of an adult's hand. These insects are introducing our students from preschool through fourth grade to coding and computational thinking. The yellow bee can remember a sequence of up to forty commands, directing it to move forwards and backwards in 15 cm increments, and to turn 90 degrees left and right. Students select buttons on top of the bee, press GO, and watch as the bee follows their every command. In addition to coding and programming, students are learning cause and effect, and they are fine tuning their collaborating skills. There are hosts of other skillsets that can be mastered, such as the practice of multiplication tables through the use of unit squares. The bees are rechargeable and rest in their "hives" when not in use. The Innovation Lab is the latest exciting addition to Holy Rosary. We invite you to visit us in January during Catholic Schools Week to see firsthand, the *Bees Bots*, the *Sphero* robots, the Lego wall, and so much more.

Dear Family & Friends:

I am writing to share with you a program that allows you to direct the state taxes that you are already paying to help students afford the Catholic education that we offer here at Holy Rosary Regional Catholic School.

The Educational Improvement Tax Credits, EITC, program is designed to allow eligible businesses and individuals to designate their tax dollars to support schools such as Holy Rosary. This is one of the few opportunities you have to direct your tax dollars to a destination you designate. These donations are then used for tuition assistance.

Simply put EITC allows you to redirect your state tax dollars to Holy Rosary to help families with tuition assistance and to keep our school thriving. The program required a minimum of only \$1,000. You are eligible if you individually pay OR your business pays \$1,000 or more a year in income taxes to the State of Pennsylvania. In return you receive a 90% tax credit for your two-year commitment.

There are two families who currently participate in EITC, and they would also gladly answer your questions. Finally, you may also join one of the informational webinars that are listed below.

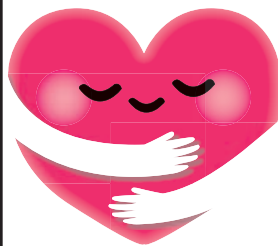
