**APPLICANT’S MOTION TO STRIKE OR WITHDRAW THE  
PETITION FILED MARCH 18, 2026, AND FOR LEAVE TO FILE A  
CORRECTED PETITION**

Applicant Lawrence Justin Mills respectfully moves the Court for an order:

1. striking or permitting withdrawal of the petition for review filed on March 18, 2026;
2. granting leave to file the corrected petition submitted contemporaneously with this motion as a substitute petition; or, in the alternative,
3. accepting the corrected petition submitted contemporaneously with this motion as an amended petition and treating it as applicant's operative submission.

This motion is made on the grounds that the petition filed on March 18, 2026, was not the version applicant approved for filing and does not accurately reflect applicant’s facts and grounds for review.



In support of this motion, applicant states as follows:

1. This matter arises under Rule 17 of the Rules for Admission to the Bar.
2. A petition for review was filed on March 18, 2026.
3. The petition filed on March 18, 2026, was not the version applicant approved for filing.
4. The March 18, 2026 petition does not accurately reflect applicant's facts and grounds for review.
5. Applicant has prepared a corrected petition, attached to this motion, and respectfully requests leave for that corrected petition to be filed and considered in place of, or alternatively as an amended version of, the March 18, 2026 petition.
6. Applicant respectfully asks the Court not to treat the March 18, 2026 petition as applicant's operative presentation of the case.

WHEREFORE, applicant respectfully requests that the Court enter an order:

- A. striking or permitting withdrawal of the petition for review filed on March 18, 2026;
- B. granting leave to file the attached corrected petition as a substitute petition; or, alternatively,
- C. accepting the attached corrected petition as an amended petition and treating it as applicant's operative submission; and
- D. granting such other and further relief as the Court deems just and appropriate.
