In re Petition of Lawrence Justin Mills, for
Review of Decision of Board of Law Examiners.

O R D E R

On March 18, 2026, petitioner Lawrence Justin Mills filed a petition for review of the decision of the Minnesota State Board of Law Examiners (Board) that denied Mills' application for admission to the Minnesota bar.

On March 24, 2026, Mills filed a motion to strike or withdraw his March 18 petition and for leave to file a corrected petition. Mills separately submitted a corrected petition with his motion. The Board filed a response and took no position on the merits of petitioner's motion. On March 27, 2026, the Board filed a motion to stay the briefing schedule pending our decision on petitioner's March 24 motion.

Based upon all the files, records, and proceedings herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the motion of petitioner Lawrence Justin Mills to strike or withdraw his March 18 petition and for leave to file a corrected petition is granted. The corrected petition is accepted as filed and served as of March 24, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion of the Board to stay the briefing schedule is granted. The Board has 20 days from the date of this order to file and serve a response to the corrected petition.
