

21 November, 2021

There is One King: His Name is JESUS. Put HIM FIRST!

### **Christ The King, Solemnity**

"My kingdom does not belong to this world."

Today, our last Sunday of Ordinary Time for experiencing a rise of secularithms liturgical year, we celebrate Our Lord and individualism with an increase. So how God's existence and authority. Can we understand Christ's Kingdom?

Does this sound at all familiary.

Jesus himself said in St. Luke's Gospel:

"The coming of the Kingdom of God cannot be observed, and no one will announce, 'Look, here it is,' or 'There it is.' For behold, the Kingdom of God is among you"

(Lk 17:20-21).

# In his famous book 'Jesus of Nazareth' Pope Benedict XVI wrote about three ways in which Christ's Kingdom may be understood.:

- 1. Jesus himself is the Kingdom.
- 2. In the mystical sense, Jesus is actually Christ the King is needed now more than ever. present within us, the Body of Christ.

  Hear the words of Christ Himself as He is
- 3. The Church is God's Kingdom on earth.

This week, on the verge of a new Church year and the holy season of Advent when we begin our study of St. Luke's Gospel, is an ideal time to take stock of every part of our lives, to see if we really are allowing Christ to reign over all parts of our daily lives; to ask if He comes first in our schedules, in our yearly budgets, with the use of our skills and talents.

Now is also a great moment to celebrate and to rejoice! You see, we are not only loyal and faithful servants of Christ the King, but we are also His brothers and sisters.

History of Christ the King:

This Solemnity of Christ the King was instituted by Pope Pius XI less than 100 years ago in 1925, during a wild time that was called



### 'The Roaring Twenties'

It was shortly after the terrible World War I, the Russian Revolution, and the fall of four of the world's five great empires. The world was experiencing a rise of secularism, materialism and individualism with an increasing denial of God's existence and authority.

Does this sound at all familiar? Pope Pius XI's hope was that the establishment of this feast would accomplish three goals:

- 1. That nations would see that the Church has the right to freedom
- 2. That leaders and nations would see that they are required to give respect to Christ, the King of kings, and
- 3. That the Catholic faithful would be strengthened and encouraged by the reminder that Jesus Christ must reign in our hearts, minds, wills and bodies.

Christ the King is needed now more than ever. Hear the words of Christ Himself as He is questioned by Pontius Pilate, Christ clearly, openly and boldly declares:

"My kingdom does not belong to this world" and "For this I was born and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth."

Next week we begin the Season of Advent and we prepare for His birth....

### Did you know...?

Anointing of the Sick is administered to the dying as well as those who are gravely ill or about to undergo an operation. This sacrament of mercy and healing offers prayers for recovery, but its primary intention is to give strength and calm the soul of one suffering. Traditionally, this sacrament was called Extreme Unction or Last Rites.

Contact the parish office if you or a loved one is ill or hospitalized and would like to be anointed.

Please note: Anointing is not to be delayed to the last minute and a person who has been anointed once doesn't need to be anointed again within the same illness.


