A great holiday dish in Ethiopia is Doro Wat. It is a spicy deep red stew flavored by Berbere, a pepper based spice. It takes over a day to make with kilos of onions, chicken, and a boiled egg. We eat it with our hands using our staple sour, spongy flat bread named injera.
