Coaching	Four hours Individual Leadership Coaching with Guy Perrin (Zoom, Facetime, Phone). Six months access.
Resources	Practical workbook; up to three leadership titles (self select or by recommendation. Hardcopy or Audible).
Certificate	Framed Certificate upon completion.
