


NATURE'S HEALING with NATIONAL PARKS



Visiting National Parks is a marvelous way to heal while experiencing nature's finery. Spending time outside in nature reduces stress, lowers anxiety, and brings a sense of peace to our challenging lives.

Three of the U.S.'s most dramatic National Parks are related in an unusual fashion.

The bottom of Bryce National Park, home of tall, inspiring stalagmite-type spires called hoodoos, is the top layer of Zion National Park.





The bottom of **Zion**, filled with sedimentary layers of stunning earth colors, is the top layer of the Grand Canyon.



The **Grand Canyon**, our nation's dramatic example of depth, vastness, and majesty, was formed by the Colorado River downcutting, carving out the canyon's beauty over millions of years.

Thus, the bottom layer of rock at Bryce Canyon is the top layer of Zion, and the bottom layer of Zion is the top layer of the Grand Canyon.

How is this possible? Volcanic eruptions and sediment carried by fast-moving streams erode rock. Earth uplifts cause multitudes of geological transformations. Stunning rock layers of magnificent beauty are formed during different times of evolutionary development, even in a similar location.

During this period of massive societal upheaval, I encourage you to spend time outside, comforting yourself with nature's beauty and transformational continuity.
