### **1) Scratch Programming Level 1: (Ages 7-9)**

The kids will learn to code using Scratch and other programming tools. They will learn how to use blocks of code to make apps. The kids will see how they can use code to program the computer draw shapes, spirals and make fun games. Block coding is similar to fitting pieces of a puzzle together and is the perfect entry level coding class for younger children!

### **2) WeDo Lego Robotics Level 1 (Grades 2-5)**

This class is for children in grades 2- 5 who love Legos! The children will block code on the computers and send commands to the Lego robots they build. The students will learn about basic color and motion sensors and robot mechanisms. They will make race cars, moon rovers, glowing snails and more! Fee \$100 (6 sessions)

### **3) Magic of Reading: (Grades 1st - 2nd)**

This class provides an environment where children can gain confidence reading and practicing literacy playing fun games and doing arts and crafts that make books come alive. The children will work on word analysis, summarizing text orally and in writing, fluency in oral reading, encoding and decoding, and more! Fee \$100 (6 sessions)

### **4) Intro To Drawing & Painting (Ages 4-7 & Ages 8-12)**

Our adventures in art will begin with taking a deep dive into drawing using shading, shapes, lines and colors. The kids will use pastels, watercolors, and color pencils. The children will begin to create symmetry, negative space, and patterns. All art supplies will be provided. All art sessions provide new experiences and projects.

Fee: \$95 for 5 sessions - includes all materials

### **5) Pathways Intro to Archery (Ages 8-12)**

Archery is a sport where children gain attention and focus. Children will learn how to hold a bow and properly align real arrows to shoot at targets. They will learn safety and how to track their scores when the arrows hit the targets. We supply all equipment. Fee \$117 for 7 classes.

### **6) Pathways Flag Rugby (Ages 6-12)**

This is a 6-week clinic where children will learn basic flag rugby skills such as passing, catching, kicking, and running the rugby ball down the field. They will learn basic plays and how to implement them with other players on their team. The kids will learn both offense and defense as they play each other in teams. This is a non-contact - flag rugby and Coach Monrad makes it fun for kids of all abilities! Fee: \$100 - 6 sessions

### **7) Pathways Pickle Ball (Ages 9-14)**

Pickle ball has become the fastest growing sport in the United States! It is a cross between regular tennis and table tennis. The kids use wooden paddles and balls similar to wiffle balls. They play on a designated court with a net that spans the pickle ball court. This program is a 6-week clinic where children will learn basic pickle ball skills and how to play within the lines and limits of the court. They will learn basic rules, offense and defense, and team play. Kids will be divided by age and ability level. We supply all equipment.

### **8) Pathways Floor Hockey (Ages 5-9)**

Pathways is excited to begin floor hockey. The children will learn the skills of hockey while using a padded hockey stick and padded puck. They will practice passing and shooting goals. They will learn offense/defense, and experience the fun of teamwork while playing games. Pathways supplies all of the equipment. Please note all equipment including pucks are padded. Fee: \$100 for 6 classes.

## **9) Pathways Tennis Program (Ages 9-13)**

Pathways will be having tennis at the beautiful Knoll Tennis Club!

The kids will learn the basic hits such as forehand, backhand, and volley. They will practice accuracy in hitting it correctly over the net and get an introduction to serving. Footwork and moving well on the court will also be covered. Kids must bring their own tennis racket.
