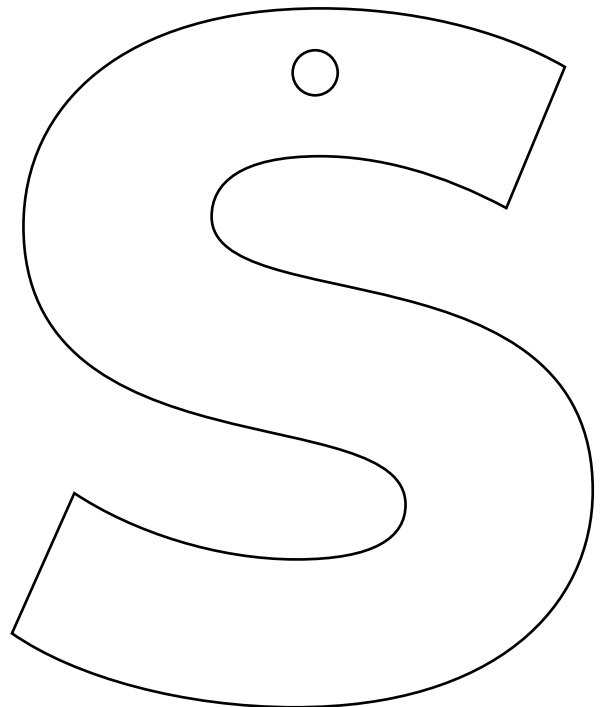
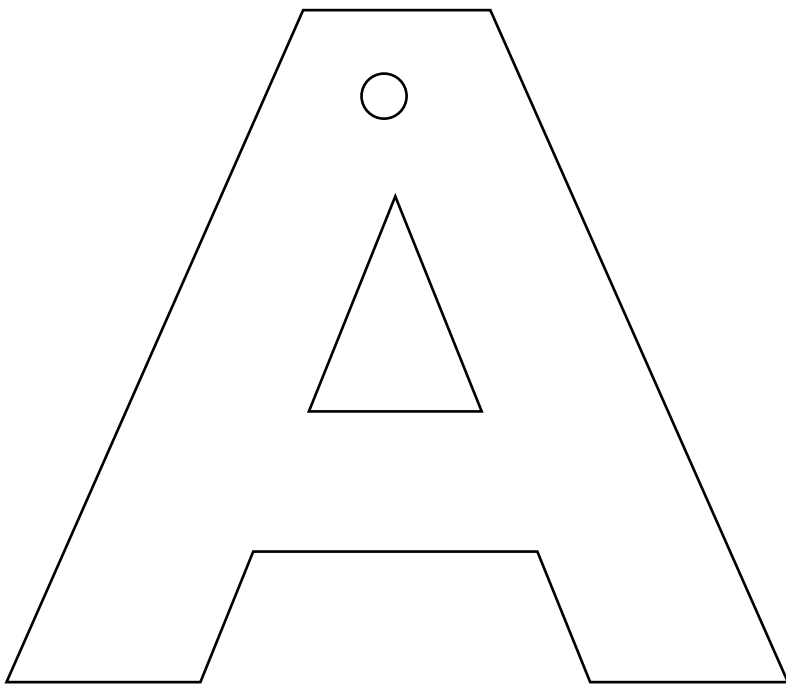
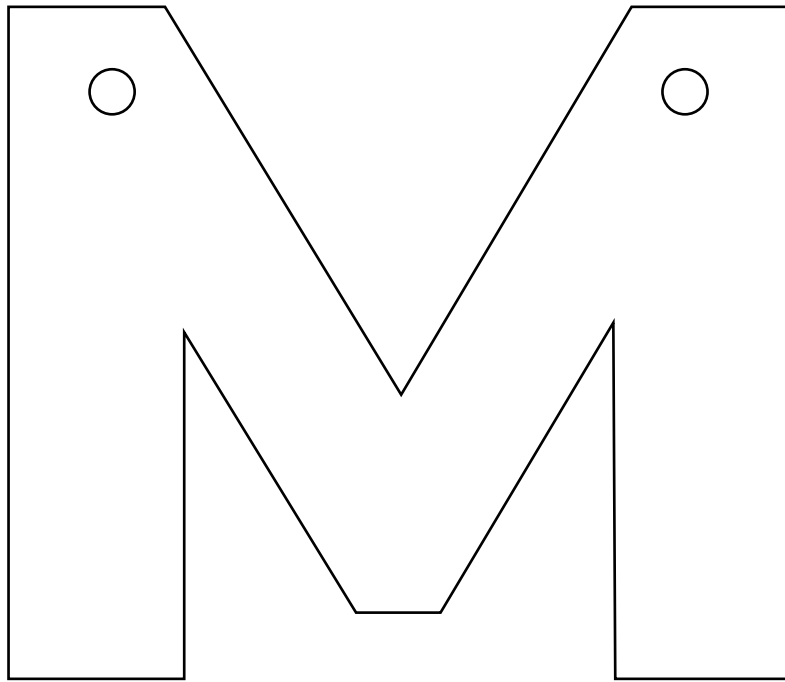
Supplies: crayons, scissors, pencil, string, tape

Supplies: crayons, glue, construction paper

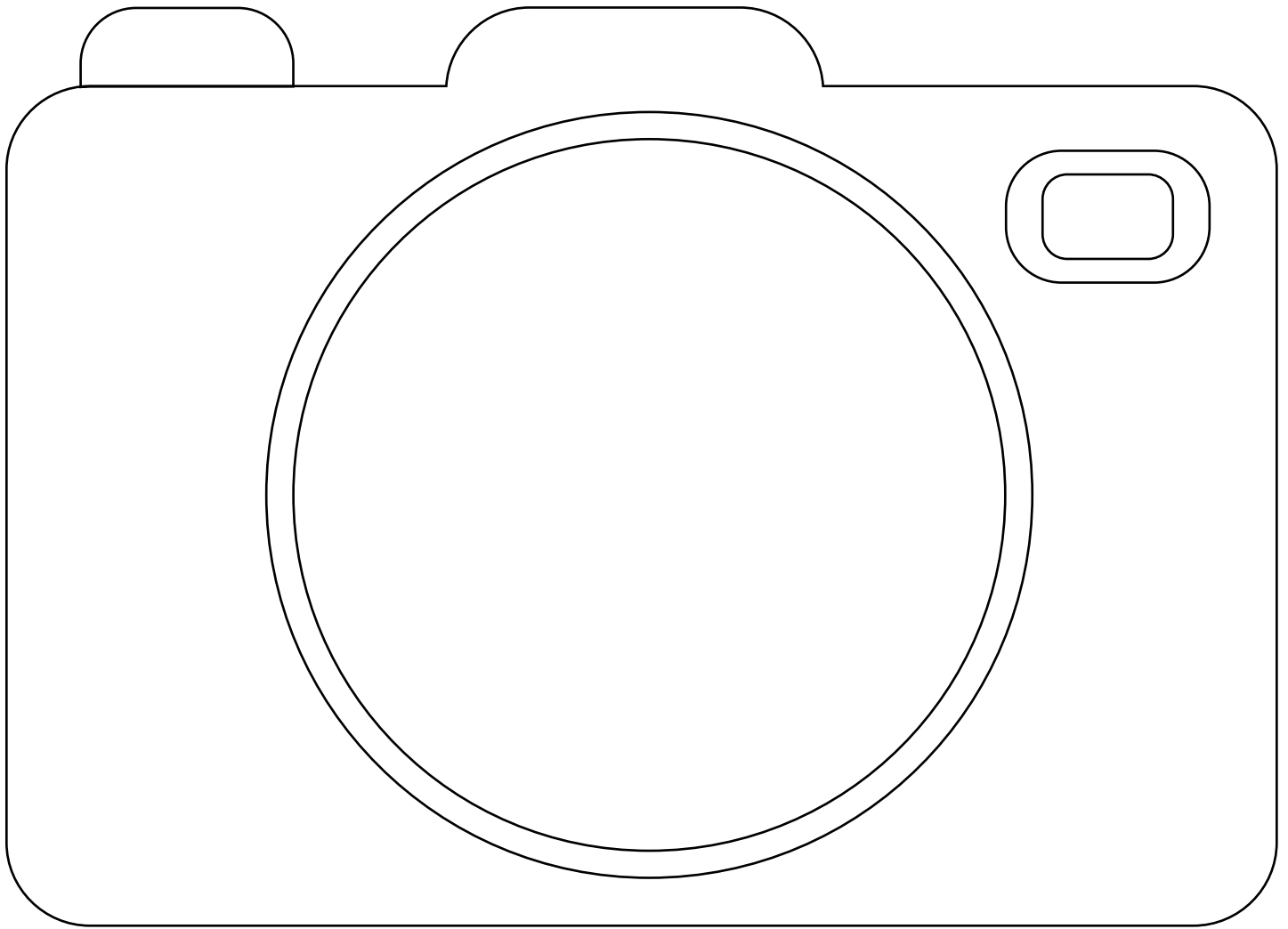

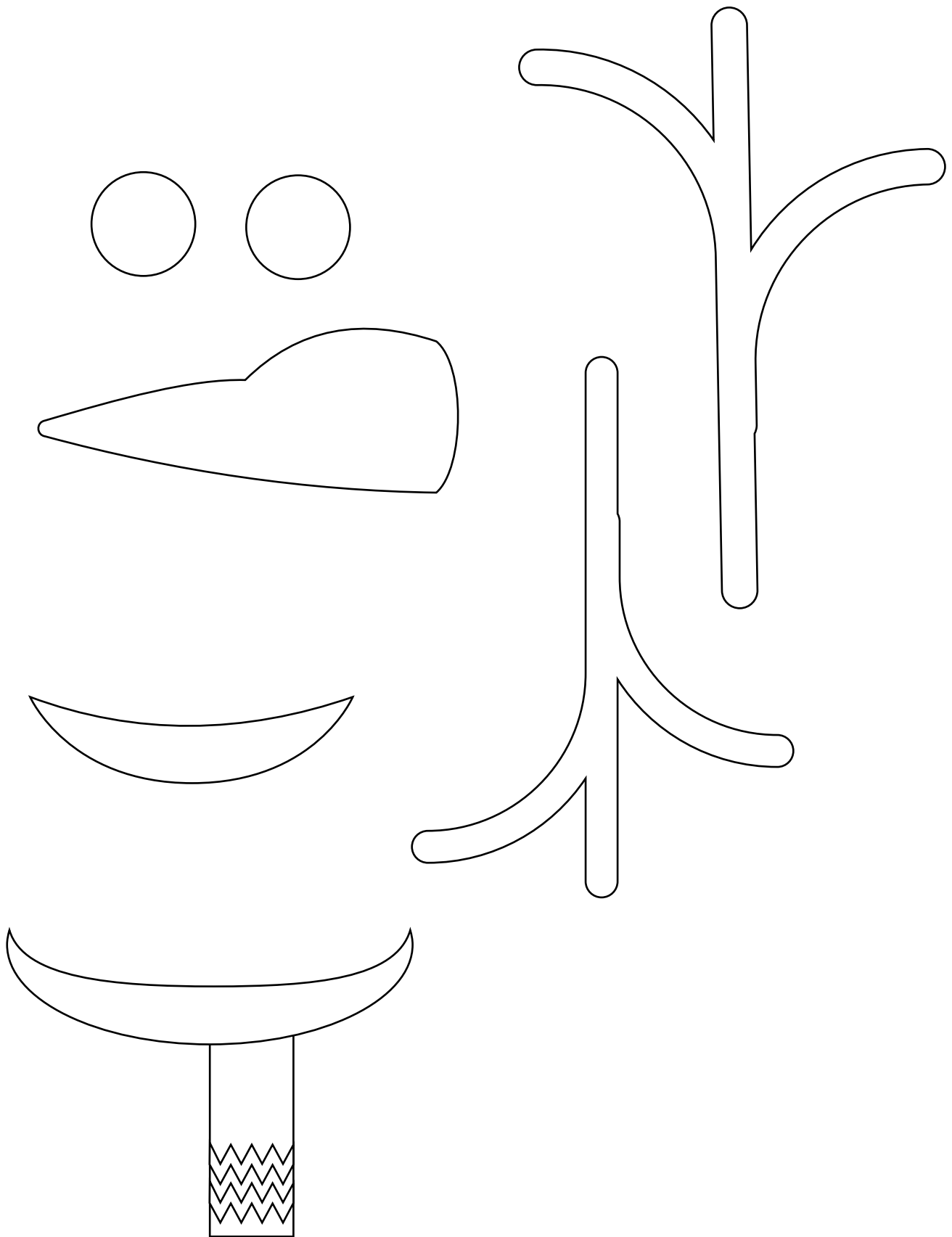


Wanna build a snowman?

3. Build your own snowman, glue the pieces on construction paper and put it on the door of your freezer, where it's cold!

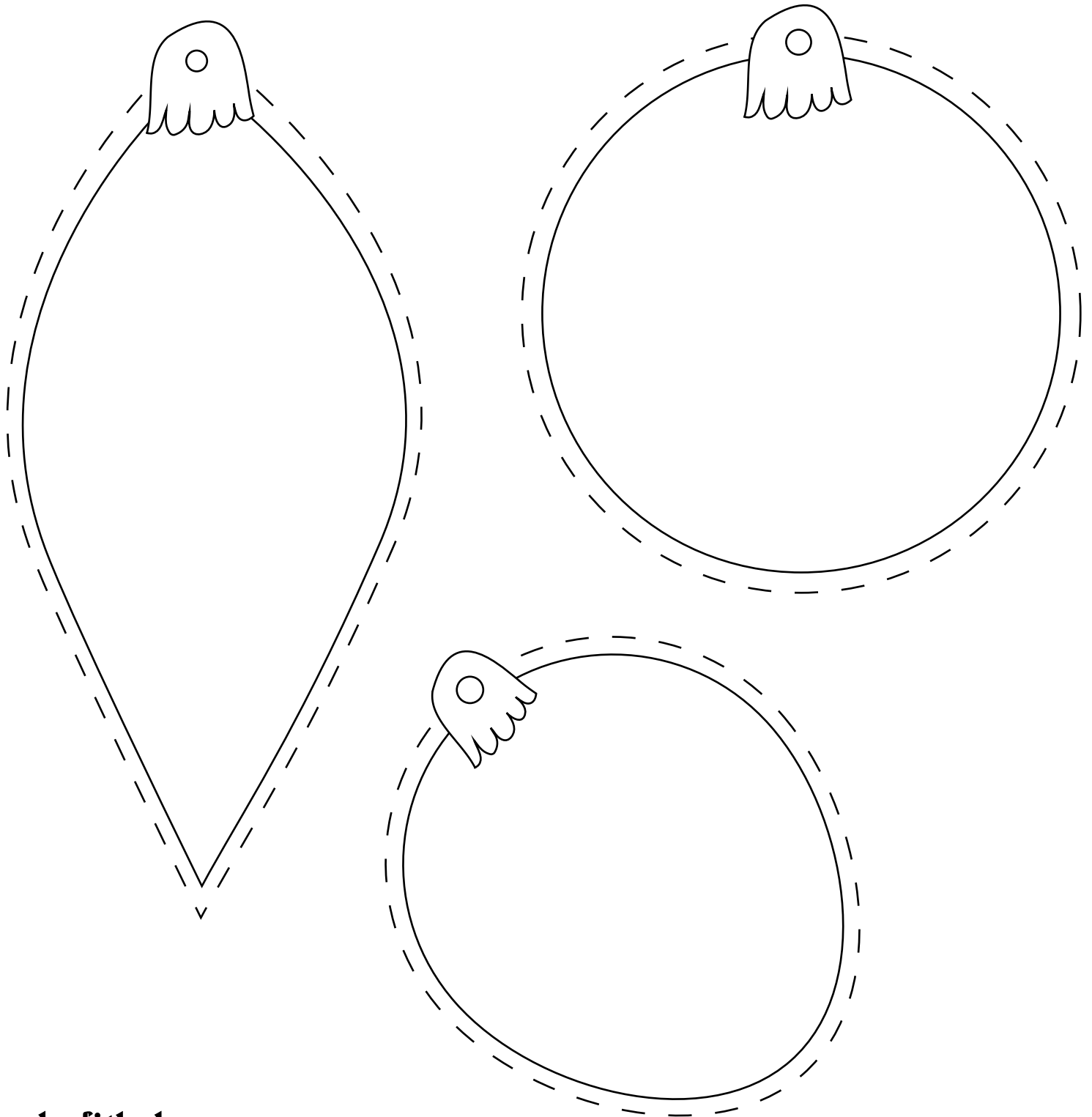




Make your own decorations.

Supplies: crayons, glitter, scissors, string

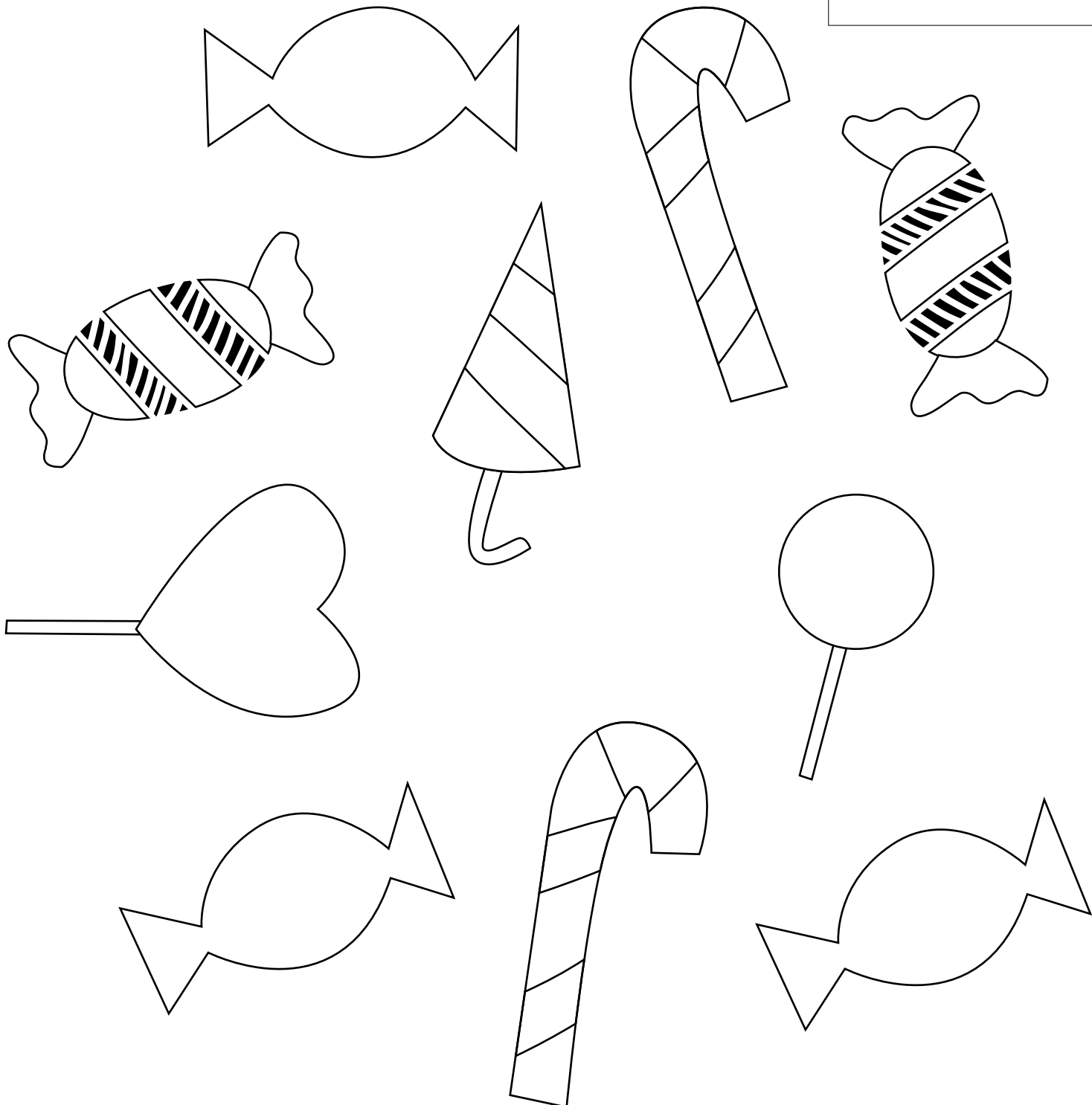
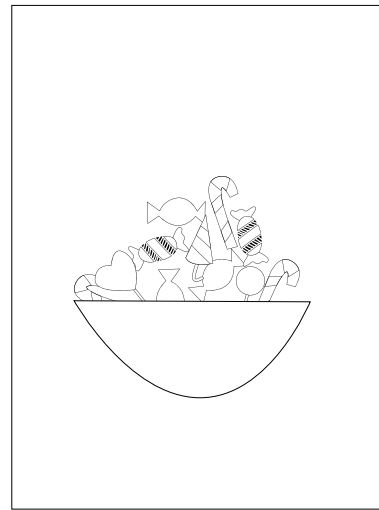
1. Color in your ornaments with patterns, color, or add glitter!

Supplies: crayons, 2 pieces of construction paper, scissors, and glue

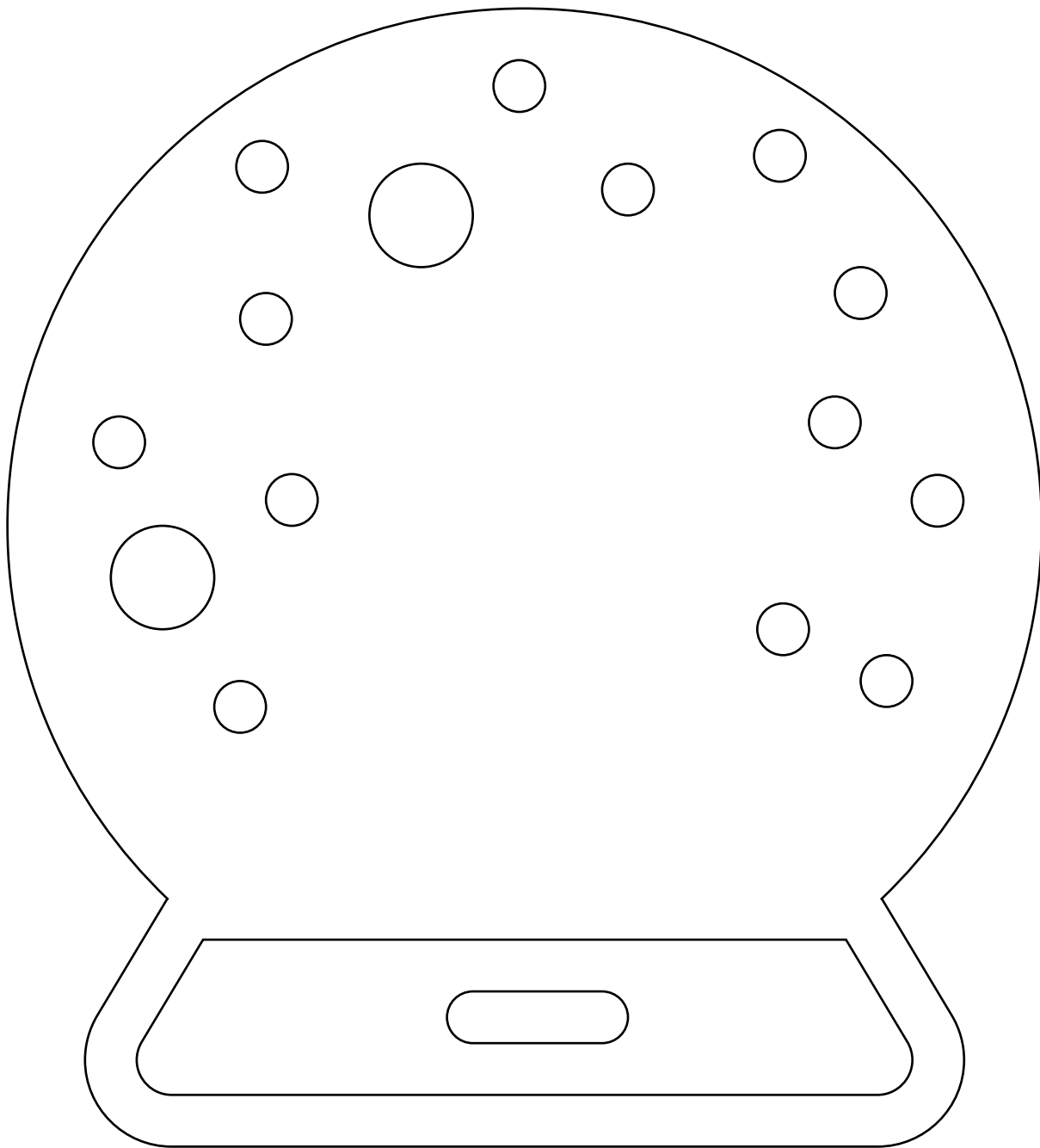
1. Color all of the candies below and cut them.

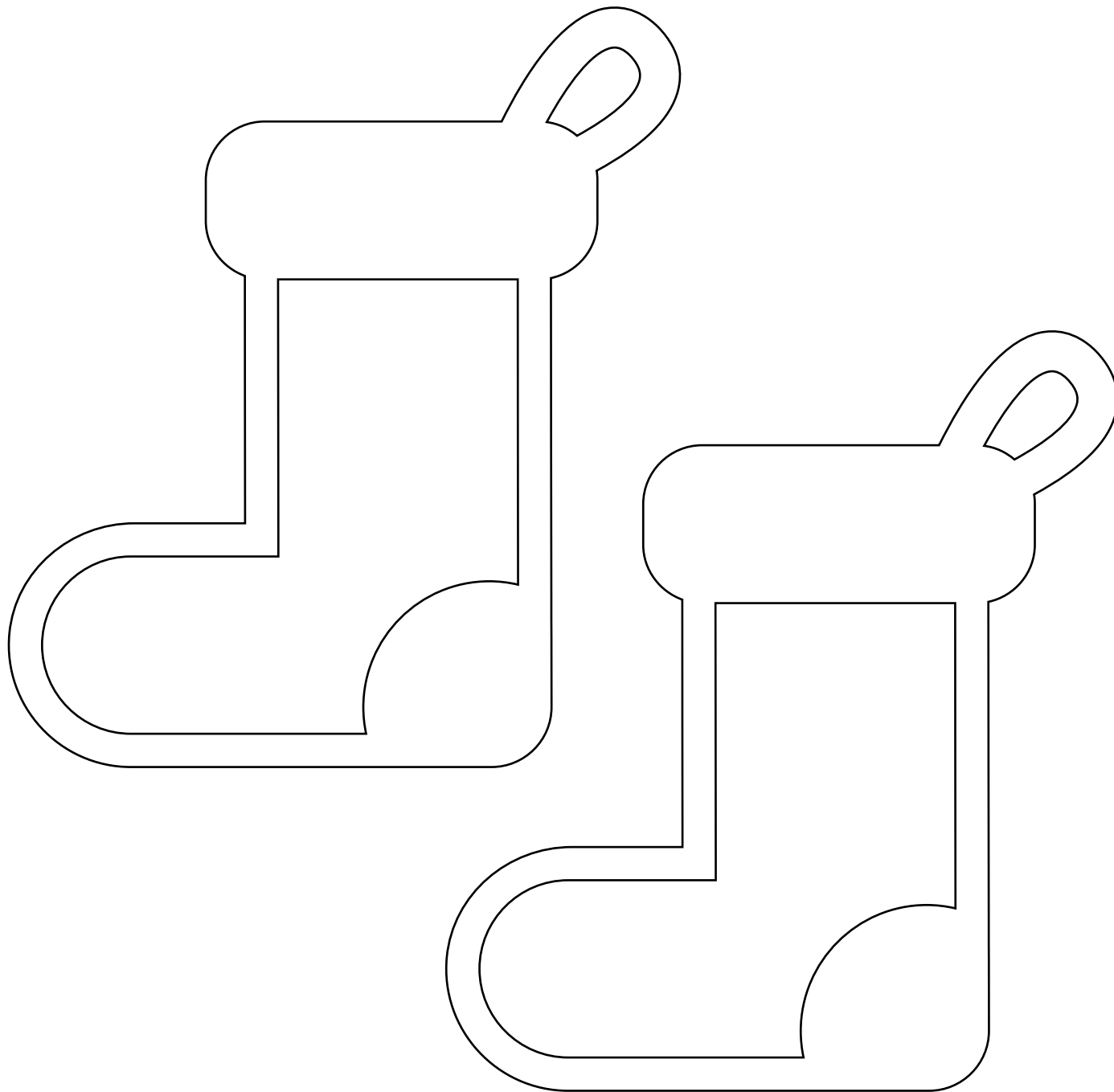
Decorate your socks

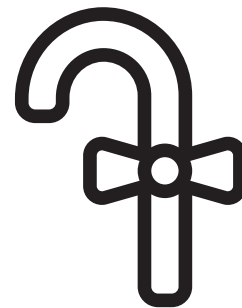
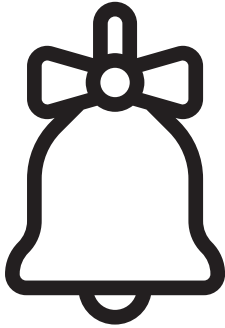
